WAND-TV Community Outreach Involvement: April, May, June 2006

Public Affairs had the opportunity to produce a **Katrina Relief Documentary** of a local Mission Trip to Mississippi's Gulf Coast. Fifteen volunteers from around Decatur traveled down to Ocean Springs, Mississippi to help with the rebuilding effort. They worked on two homes of two retirement aged women and got both homes ready for carpet and cabinets. A news story of the trip ran several times and there was a public affairs show presenting the documentary. The purpose of the coverage was to show the overwhelming need of help still needed in the Gulf States and the work this one group was able to accomplish in one week. The help was just a drop in the bucket of what is still needed to be done, but it was high significant to the two women they helped.

The **National Association Letter Carriers Food Drive** was May 13. Anchor Sean Streaty and a postal worker did a PSA for the drive. They collected approximately 80 thousand pounds this year.

Junior Achievement, Careers on Wheels was in mid May. Jon McCall and I gave dozens of presentations about our live truck to a couple thousand 4th Graders.

The **WAND-TV Fan Club** is under way. It will run June 13 through July 9. So far local Senior Centers have collected over 200 fans.
