Recently, the Decatur School District began a series of meetings to explore the possibility of combining the city's two public high schools into one. It gave public tours of Eisenhower & MacArthur to show the public the deteriorating condition of the two buildings, and their deficiencies when it comes to keeping up with today's technology. Right now there's no price tag, or plans to pay for it. The next step will be more meetings to gather public input.. the first being June 11th at Eisenhower. The Springfield School District is also considering a new high school building. In this time of state budget cuts.. where would the money come from? Voters could see referenda asking to raise their property taxes, but those often fail. Another option could be the one percent state sales tax for schools that Champaign County voters passed in April. This tax would not only benefit the Springfield and Decatur school districts, but also the smaller districts in Sangamon and Macon counties that would like to improve or build new schools of their own. It's our opinion that whether or not you have children attending these schools, you should pay close attention to what's being considered, and get involved in the process. The future of our children is what's at stake.

YOU CAN THANK YOUR LOCAL PEACE OFFICERS FOR THAT. AND ABOUT THAT SPEEDING TICKET YOU GOT LAST MONTH. THE BILL PUTS LIMITS ON INDIVIDUAL CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.. BUT THOSE LIMITS DON'T KICK IN UNTIL AFTER THE 2010 ELECTIONS. IT'S ALSO CHOCK-FULL OF LOOPHOLES THAT ALLOW SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS.. AND EVEN LEGISLATIVE AND PARTY LEADERS TO GIVE LARGE WADS OF CASH TO A PARTICULAR CANDIDATE! AND THIS IS CALLED REFORM? SOUNDS MORE LIKE THE WOLF GUARDING THE HENHOUSE. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE PANEL CREATED BY GOVERNOR QUINN TO CREATE REFORM PROPOSALS SAYS THE CURRENT ETHICS BILL DOESN'T GO FAR ENOUGH. WHEN THE ILLINOIS SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF IN JACKSONVILLE FACES CLOSURE? OR DOES 500 THOUSAND DOLLARS OF YOUR TAX MONEY REALLY NEED TO BE SPENT ON A POPEYE'S CHICKEN TRAINING CENTER.. WHEN MACON RESOURCES IN DECATUR STANDS TO LOSE THAT MUCH STATE FUNDING? WHERE ARE YOUR PRIORITIES SPRINGFIELD? GOVERNOR QUINN APPEARS TO BE BACKING AWAY FROM HIS THREAT...WHICH IS A GOOD THING.
