# Community Issues – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter <u>Crime</u>

Crime remains a top concern with people living in the Decatur – Champaign – Springfield areas. Topics covered included everything from public safety (shootings, sexual assaults, murders) to scam warnings.

#### **Government**

Government issues played a huge role in our coverage during the second quarter. The governor stripped away lawmakers' salaries (including his own) because of their failure to come up with a solution on pension reform. The court ruled pay should be re-instituted; however, the governor appealed.

### **Education**

The realities of spending cuts settled in as children went back to school. Also, very few districts met No Child Left Behind standards.

#### Economy& Jobs

Major industries continued to lay off workers in Decatur. City and state lawmakers got together in an effort to find common sense solutions. WAND put together a series of interviews to tell people where the jobs are, how to get trained, and what they need to do to apply.

#### Health and Public Safety

Issues ranged from the safety of HPV vaccine to childhood obesity.

## <u>Military</u>

Military depression (and growing number of suicides), veterans benefits, and various benefits put together to benefit veterans highlighted WAND's coverage.
