### 7/8 Cameras in Police Cars

This week in a Stormcenter 17 special investigation, we looked into why our local police departments have very few dashboard cameras in their squad cars. Police chiefs and County Sheriffs say it's the cost: 5-thousand dollars apiece. In 2000.. state lawmakers passed a law which was supposed to raise money to pay for them. It's called Shawna's Law.. named after a teenager killed by a drunk driver. 100 dollars from each drunk driving fine goes to the arresting police agency to pay for equipment like dashcams.. to combat drunk driving. But in these tough times.. many police departments have been forced to use that money for other expenses.. which the law allows them to do. So what can be done? Dashcams give police and prosecutors valuable evidence to build a case against an alleged drunk driver. And as two recent cases show.. they can also help determine whether or not the use of deadly force was warranted. Since the idea behind Shawna's Law was to make convicted drunk drivers pay for these cameras, maybe lawmakers in Springfield need to consider increasing those fines. That would be a start. ### 7/16 Capitol Projects

ON MONDAY, GOVERNOR QUINN FINALLY SIGNED THE 31 BILLION DOLLAR CAPITAL SPENDING PLAN INTO LAW. THIS IS A 90 PAGE LIST OF PROJECTS THAT WILL RECEIVE MONEY.. AND PUT AS MANY AS 300 TO 400-THOUSAND PEOPLE TO WORK IMPROVING OUR STATE'S SCHOOLS, ROADS AND BRIDGES AND OTHER PROJECTS. THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS CAN NOW IMPROVE OLD FACILITIES AND BUILD NEW ONES.. THE FINAL PHASE OF THE ROUTE 29 PROJECT IN CHRISTIAN COUNTY WILL BE COMPLETED. MAJOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS WILL HAPPEN IN DECATUR AND SPRINGFIELD. BUT DURING A MEETING WITH OUR EDITORIAL BOARD.. STATE TREASURER ALEXI GIANNOULIAS SAID IT'S IMPORTANT TO INVEST IN OUR INFRASTRUCTURE WHEN TIMES ARE BAD. BUT HE ALSO SAID THE PRIORITIES OF SOME PROJECTS IS UP FOR DEBATE. GIANNOULIAS SAYS IF THE STATE WAS FLUSH WITH CASH.. HE WOULDN'T HAVE PROBLEMS WITH SOME OF THE PROJECTS GETTING FUNDED. BUT HE FEELS SOME OF THIS MONEY COULD BE BETTER USED ELSEWHERE. OVERALL.. THE CAPITAL BILL IS A GOOD THING FOR CENTRAL ILLINOIS.. AND THE ENTIRE STATE. BUT SOME OF THE PROJECTS RECEIVING FUNDING GIVE IT THE ODOR OF PORK BARREL POLITICS. THAT'S OUR OPINION; WE'D LIKE TO HEAR YOURS. ### 7/31 Dept of Corrections Cuts

On Friday, Governor Quinn unveiled a list of across the board budget cuts aimed at reducing the state's budget gap. While we agree cuts are needed, we question the wisdom of one area he's cutting: Department of Corrections. The Governor wants to give nearly six-thousand inmates statewide a Get Out of Jail Free card.. and cut more than a thousand Corrections workers. This has trouble written all over it. Our prisons are already severely understaffed as it is now.. and this will just make the situation even worse. Many of the inmates who may get out early are already telling prison staff that they'll be back in a couple months.. and they're probably right. So when that happens, and more people get convicted of crimes and sent to prison, we eventually end up with as many or even more people behind bars.. and fewer people to babysit them. There's a reason why these people are in Governor Quinn's bed and breakfast: THEY'RE CRIMINALS! These are not nice people. They committed crimes and deserve to be locked up.. not sent back on the street to re-offend. It's our opinion that this is a safety issue.. not only to society, but also to the people who work inside the razor wire to provide for their families. We believe there may be better places where the Governor can make cuts.

### 9/3 U of I Trustees

This week, Governor Quinn plans to fill the remaining five open seats on the University of Illinois Board of Trustees. Hopefully this is a sign that the whole admissions scandal that's dragged the U of I's good name through the mud is about over with. The board is scheduled to meet on September 10th.. and one big issue the new board will eventually have to take up is the futures of President B. Joseph White and Chancellor Richard Hermann. Chancellor Hermann admitted to the U of I faculty-student senate last week that he made mistakes in how he handled admissions inquiries from influential people. President White denied any knowledge of the so-called "Category I" list of potential student candidates who had political connections. The Senate may vote September 14th to send Governor Quinn a letter recommending White and Hermann's removal. Such action would be up to the Board of Trustees.. not the Governor. We urge the Board of Trustees to quickly decide whether White and Hermann should stay or go, so the University can move forward and go about it's mission of giving it's students a world-class education. ### 9/11 High Speed Rail

The city of Springfield and Union Pacific railroad are locked in a battle over the planned high speed rail service that would go through town. City leaders say building overpasses and closing crossings along the Third street rail corridor for the trains will ruin downtown businesses and the city's medical district. They say the Tenth street rail corridor or building a new rail line bypassing the downtown area are better options. Union Pacific and I-Dot say the Third street corridor is the only option.. and the city's opposition jeopardizes high speed rail for the entire state. So far.. Everyone agrees that high speed rail service would be a win-win for the state of Illinois. But time is running out to resolve the issue. The state has three weeks to submit it's application to the federal government for the two-point three billion dollars in funding for the project. IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR WHEN THE RURAL AREAS OF THE MIDWEST GET AWFULLY BUSY. FROM NOW UNTIL THANKSGIVING AND POSSIBLY BEYOND, COMBINES, TRACTORS, TRUCKS AND WAGONS WILL BE USING THE ROADS FROM WELL BEFORE DAYLIGHT 'TIL LONG AFTER DARK. ON BOARD THAT EQUIPMENT WILL BE TIRE FARMERS WHO ARE BUSILY GOING FROM FIELD TO FARM YARD GETTING IN THIS YEARS LATE HARVEST OF CORN AND SOYBEANS. BECAUSE THEY ARE SHARING THE ROADS WITH CARS LOT CAN SOMETIMES GET CONGESTED AND NERVES GET ON EDGE. EVERY YEAR WE HEAR ABOUT FARM AUTO ACCIDENTS THAT, POSSIBLY, COULD HAVE BEEN AVOIDED. MAKE SURE THEY CAN SEE YOU AND THEN WAIT FOR YOUR OPPORTUNITY. WHEN YOU SEE EQUIPMENT'S FLASHING LIGHTS OR THE COMMON SLOW MOVING VEHICLE SIGN, IT'S YOUR SIGNAL TO START SLOWING DOWN AND MAKE YOURSELF VISIBLE TO THE FARMER ON BOARD. COUNTRY ROADS PROVIDE BEUTIFUL SCENERY AT THIS TIME OF THE YEAR ALONG WITH TREES, OUR CROPS ARE TURNING BEUTIFUL COLORS AND WATCHING A FARMER TAKE OUT THIS CROP IS TRULY AN AMAZING FEAT OF EFFICIENCY.
