

Re: Alternative Broadcast Inspection Program Certificate

Congratulations! Enclosed, please find your New Jersey Broadcasters Association Alternative Broadcast Inspection Program *Certificate of Compliance* for WCHR-AM. Your certificate should be placed in plain view in one of two places:

- 1) On the wall on the entrance area of the main studio or station control point; or
- 2) In the station's FCC authorization binder, if it has one.

Your station now has the right to verbally inform any person who enters the main studio of the station – who identifies himself/herself as an FCC inspector seeking to conduct an FCC inspection- that the station holds a valid *Certificate of Compliance* from the New Jersey Broadcasters Association.

Your station is now safe from further FCC inspection – notwithstanding a "Targeted Tower Safety Inspection," "Complaint Driven Inspection," or the inspection of any EEO or political advertising materials required to be placed in your station's public file – for a period of three years from the date on the certificate.
