On today's edition of Family Talk, Dr. Christina Francis, chairwoman of the board of the American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists, tells our own Dr. Tim Clinton that she is hopeful that *Roe v. It is a natural process of the body!"

One day, Katherine Wolf was a 26-year-old wife and the doting mother to her six month old baby boy. The next day, without warning, she suffered a massive brain stem stroke. Today, fourteen years later, Katherine is living her best life possible, given so many physical obstacles. Katherine exhorts believers to acknowledge their own "invisible" wheelchairs and how God can use their weaknesses for His glory.

been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things." No matter what trial you're enduring, Katherine calls you to persevere.

According to Senator James Lankford of Oklahoma, the leaked draft of the Supreme Court opinion that could overturn *Roe v. Wade* has changed the American conversation. The debate is no longer whether it's convenient or not for the mother to be pregnant. Now we're discussing the value of babies in the womb again. On today's edition of Family Talk, Senator Lankford urges all Americans to move from making abortion illegal to making abortion unthinkable.
