Subject: SM-KQCH, LLC - KQCH(FM) Req. for Extension of Time

Good afternoon, Mr. Pulley -

I am writing on behalf of SM-KQCH, LLC, licensee of Station KQCH(FM), Omaha, Nebraska (Fac. ID No. 50314) to respectfully request an extension of time to respond to the FCC's February 14, 2019 EEO Audit Letter. KQCH is part of a station employment unit ("SEU") with commonly-owned stations KXSP(AM), KSRZ(FM), KKCD(FM) and KEZO-FM, all also located in Omaha, Nebraska. SummitMedia LLC, the parent company of the licensees, began programming these Stations via a Local Marketing Agreement on September 1, 2018 and subsequently acquired all five radio station licenses on November 1, 2018 (See BALH-20180828ABC, BAL/BALH-20180828ABE-ABH.)

The former licensee of these Stations conducted recruitment for the full-time job openings that appear on the abbreviated 2019 EEO Public File Report. Since receipt of the FCC EEO Audit Letter, SummitMedia has sought copies of documentation that supports the former licensee's outreach efforts but, as of today, not all material has been provided. For these reasons, SM-KQCH, LLC, respectfully requests a one month extension of time, until May 1, 2019, to continue its efforts to obtain documentation from the former licensee of the Omaha stations, which will hopefully allow SM-KQCH, LLC to finalize a more thorough response.
