We, whose names are hereto subscribed, do, by this agreement, associate ourselves with the intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180.

The name by which the corporation shall be known is The WTBS Foundation, Inc.

The location of the principal office of the corporation in Massachusetts is to be the Town or City of Cambridge Street 3Ames Street

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows: To own and operate radio and television broadcasting facilities at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and to engage in all activities relative thereto and connected therewith which are permissable under Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, as amended, and, without limitation on the above, to own real and personal property in an amount not in excess of that allowed by the Massachusetts statute; to enter into contracts in connection with the scheduling of programs; to solicit advertising and enter into contracts with advertisers; to take all necessary steps to comply with all federal or state regulations on radio and television broadcasting; and to take such other action as the authorized members of the corporation deem advisable to enhance the quality of the service rendered to the surrounding community and to make the best and most efficient use of the property owned by the corporation. The corporation may at any time be dissolved by a vote of at least three-quarters of all the members of the corporation, provided that upon dissolution all its property and assets be transferred to Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

A vote of three-quarters of all the members of the corporation shall be required to amend this Agreement of Association and the Articles of Organization.
