Quarterly Issues Program List for Station –KSIR January - March 2023

Assessment of Issues for this quarter: Issues important to our community are gleaned from Federal agencies, ag organizations and local Chambers of Commerce, law enforcement, business owners, city/county/state employees, politicians, other media, Facebook and Twitter postings, conversations with community members at community concerts, special events and other functions in the communities of our listening area.

Section I. Issues.

A. Education: Discussions with organization leaders, water educators and Colorado State University Extension especially as it relates to the region's agriculture industry.

A: Education:

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on January 26, 2023. Duration: 11 minutes. Discussion with National Cattlemen's Beef Association Vice President of Government Affairs, Ethan Lane. He talked about the current status of the Waters of the U.S. Rule, new congressional committee assignments, Farm Bill priorities, and the upcoming convention. Lorrie Boyer Phone Interview.

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on March 17, 2023. Duration: 11 minutes. Discussion with Colorado Corn Promotion Council Executive Director, Nick Colglazier. He talked about the rebranding of the organization, the recent Commodity Classic, Mexico issuing a biotech corn ban against the U.S., and the value of corn in relation to the livestock industry. Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on March 22, 2023. Duration: 8 minutes. Discussion with Mary-Thomas Hart, Chief Council for the National Cattlmen's Beef Association. She talked about recent rulings on the Waters of the US with Texas and Idaho receiving court approval to be exempt from WOTUS. D: Agriculture- Environmental and Resources related: Water and land issues.

Northeast Colorado Talks. Broadcast on January 4, 2023. Duration: 10 minutes. Discussion with Communications Specialist with Northern Water, Eric Brown. He talked about the Northern Integrated Supply Project and upcoming events that Northern Water will be at. Lorrie Boyer Phone Interview.

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on January 31, 2023. Duration: 11 minutes. Discussion with General Manager of the Pruett and North Sterling Reservoirs, Jim Yahn. He gave an area reservoir conditions update, gave a legislative update, and talked about a recent meeting he spoke at. Lorrie Boyer Phone Interview.

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on March 23, 2023. Duration: 11 minutes. Discussion with General Manager of the Pruett and North Sterling Reservoirs, Jim Yahn. He gave a reservoir storage update and talked about a bill that would damn up water for beavers in the Western part of the state and how that is out of prior appropriations and could negatively affect downstream users. He then talked about some updates to automate reservoir headgates to make water delivery more efficient and an additional reservoir to be constructed towards the end of the delivery system to catch extra water and help mitigate fluctuations. E. Agriculture- Crop, Livestock, and Production related: Planting, harvest, crop disease, livestock issues, new technology.

She talked about their recent mid-winter conference, her being at the Colorado Farm Show next week, policy, and proposed Colorado legislation that they are watching. Lorrie Boyer Phone Interview.

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on January 20, 2023. Duration: 10 minutes. Discussion with Colorado Corn Administrative Committee Past President and National Corn Growers Association Market Development Action Team Chair, Troy Schneider. He talked about a recent NCGA meeting where action teams met to discuss work and goals. He highlighted the consumer education that they are engaging in. Lorrie Boyer Phone Interview.

Daily Ag Interview. Broadcast on March 2, 2023. Duration: 11 minutes. Discussion with Taylor Szilagyy, vice president of strategy and operations with the Colorado Farm Bureau. She introduced herself and talked about her role at CFB. She talked about a member taking part and taking third place in a national communications contest. State legislative issues- a quarter-crossing bill that they are opposed to, and other private property rights issues. In addition, they are monitoring Colorado the Right to Repair bill
