

THE WEEK IN REVIEW IN THE TIME OF CORONA VIRUS IN SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: APRIL 4, 2020

GUESTS: 1250 WTMA MORNING SHOW HOST CHARLIE JAMES....MORNING SHOW PRODUCER JOHN QUINCY...AND SHOW HOST SHEREE BERNARDI

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON A REFLECTION ON THE PAST TWO WEEKS IN THE TIME OF CORONA VIRUS. WE REVIEWED THE CONTINUED CAUTIONS WE ARE ALL URGED TO FOLLOW. THEY INCLUDE STAYING HOME.....FREQUENT HAND WASHING.....DISINFECTING SURFACES....AND STAYING AWAY FROM SICK PEOPLE.

WE ALSO DISCUSSED THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THE LOW COUNTRY AND THE STATE. TOURISM INTERESTS SAY IT CAN PROBABLY HANDLE THE ECONOMIC DOWNTURN THRU THE END OF APRIL....BUT FEAR THE FUTURE FOR MANY RETAILERS COULD BE IN DOUBT IF THE SITUATION DOESN'T CHANGE DURING THE MONTH OF MAY.

ALSO UNDER DISCUSSION....THE QUICK AND STEEP JUMP IN JOBLESS CLAIMS...ESPECIALLY IN THOSE AREAS DEPENDENT ON TOURISM AND THE FOOD AND BEVERAGE INDUSTRY.

HORDING WAS ALSO DISCUSSED....AS TOILET PAPER CAN HARDLY BE FOUND ANYWHERE. NO ONE KNOWS WHY....EXACTLY.

HAND SANITIZER....DISINFECTING WIPES ARE ALSO IN SHORT SUPPLY.

APPLY NOW FOR SMART 9-1-1 AND HOW THE CORONA VIRUS IS AFFECTING THE ARK OF SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: APRIL 12, 2020

GUESTS: JIM LAKE...DIRECTOR OF THE CHARLESTON COUNTY CONSOLIDATED 9-1-1 DISPATCH AND MEGAN SEVERN...DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT WITH THE ARK OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING...NO IN-STUDIO GUESTS. THIS PROGRAM STARTED A LIKELY TREND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. THAT IS....TWO DIFFERENT GUESTS DURING THIS 30 MINUTE PROGRAM.

JIM LAKE DISCUSSED THE IMPORTANCE OF RESIDENTS IN THE TRI-COUNTY AREA APPLYING FOR SMART 9-1-1. IT TELLS FIRST RESPONDERS MORE INFORMATION IF CALLED TO YOUR HOME. ITS THOUGHT TO BE ANOTHER WAY TO PROTECT FIRST RESPONDERS IN THIS ERA OF CORONA VIRUS. IT LETS 9-1-1 FIRST RESPONDERS KNOW WHAT THEY WILL ENCOUNTER.

MEGAN SEVERN DISCUSSED CHANGES THE ARK OF SOUTH CAROLINA HAS HAD TO ADOPT DUE TO THE CORONA VIRUS. THE ARK HELPS CAREGIVERS WHO ARE TAKING CARE OF LOVED ONES WITH DEMENTIA OR ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE. THE VIRUS CAN BE DEADLY TO THE ELDERLY. SO SOCIAL DISTANCING IS PRACTICED UNTIL THE ARK CAN RESUME MANY OF ITS SERVICES THAT GIVE CAREGIVERS A BREAK. THE ARK SAYS IT CAN'T WAIT TO RE-START MANY OF THEIR PROGRAMS THAT BENEFIT THEIR CLIENTS AND THE LOVED ONES THEY CARE FOR.

THE RED CROSS....AND GETTING THRU THE AGE OF CORONAAIR DATE: APRIL 19, 2020

GUESTS: BEN WILLIAMSON....DIRECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE LOW COUNTRY AMERICAN RED CROSS.....AND TROY NIX...MOTIVATIONAL SPEAKER AND AUTHOR OF 'ETERNAL IMPACT: INSPIRE GREATNESS IN YOURSELF AND OTHERS.

TWO PROGRAMS DURING THIS HALF HOUR. FIRST A DISCUSSION WITH WILLIAMSON ON THE RED CROSS. CORONA VIRUS WAS ALREADY CAUSING A BLOOD SHORTAGE IN THE CHARLESTON AREA. WILLIAMSON MADE IT CLEAR THAT IT IS SAFE TO DONATE BLOOD AND THAT DONATION SITES ARE CLEANED OFTEN AND EVERY PRECAUTION IS TAKEN. ACTUALLY.....ALL SUCH PRECAUTIONS HAVE ALWAYS BEEN TAKEN...AS GIVING BLOOD IS A MEDICAL-TYPE PROCEDURE. THE RED CROSS IS ALSO HELPING AT LEAST 250 RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY MONDAY'S LINE OF SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS AND DEADLY TORNADOS. SOCIAL DISTANCING HAS CHANGED THE WAY THE PROCESS IS HAPPENING. IT TAKES MORE TIME. BUT THE RED CROSS CONTINUES TO HELP.

TROY NIX WAS VERY UPLIFTING...TALKING ABOUT WAYS TO DEAL WITH ISOLATION AND SOCIAL DISTANCING DURING THE CORONA VIRUS. A VERY POSITIVE GUY...HE RELATED INSTANCES WHERE WE CAN ALL BE GRATEFUL FOR WHAT WE HAVE TODAY IN THE QUEST TO STAY HEALTHY. AS FOR BUSINESSES THAT ARE SHUTTERED...HE SAYS HE'S LEARNED IN BUSINESS THAT BUMPS IN THE ROAD WILL ONLY MAKE ONE MORE DETERMINED...AND EVEN BOUNCE BACK STRONGER WHEN THIS ORDEAL IS FINALLY BEHIND US.

MENTAL HEALTH CONCERNS IN THE TIMES OF THE CORONA VIRUS

AIR DATE: APRIL 26, 2020

GUEST: MATT DORMAN...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE BERKELEY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER IN MONCKS CORNER

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS THAT HAVE BEGUN TO SURFACE IN CONNECTION WITH THE CORONA VIRUS GUIDELINES.

SINCE MARCH...THE GOVERNOR HAS ORDERED NON-ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES CLOSED AND FOR SOUTH CAROLINAS TO STAY HOME. AND DORMAN SAYS IT HAS TAKEN A TOLL MENTALLY ON SOME.

CRISIS HOTLINES NATIONWIDE ARE SAID TO BE EXPERIENCING INCREASED CALLS. PEOPLE ARE FINDING THE NEED TO TALK. THERE ARE ALSO FRUSTRATIONS BEING DISCUSSED...SINCE WE ARE ALL SUPPOSED TO EITHER BE AT HOME OR AT WORK. AND THOUGH WE LOVE OUR FAMILIES....IT CAN ALL BE ALITTLE 'TOO MUCH FAMILY TIME'.

THERE ARE INCREASED ANXIETIES WHEN IT COMES TO MONEY AS MANY ARE NOT GETTING PAYCHECKS AND THEY ARE ALSO FINDING IT DIFFICULT TO SIGN ON FOR JOBLESS BENEFITS.

SOME YOUNG PEOPLE WHO LOVE SOCIAL MEDIA ARE FEELING TRAPPED AT HOME NOW. DORMAN SAYS SOCIAL INTERACTION IN THE SCHOOL SETTING IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE GROWTH PROCESS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE. SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN CLOSED AND THAT THE REST OF THE SCHOOL YEAR MAY BE NIXED AS A PRECAUTION. AT THIS PROGRAM RECORDING....AN

ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE REST OF THE SCHOOL YEAR WAS EXPECTED BY THE END OF THE WEEK.

LASTLY....DORMAN SAID THAT ANYONE FEELING FATALISTIC FEELINGS NEED TO CALL THEIR COUNTY'S MENTAL HEALTH AGENCY TO ASK FOR HELP.

HE SAYS NO ONE SHOULD TAKE THEIR LIFE OVER A TEMPORARY SITUATION. HE SAYS THAT EVENTUALLY....WE WILL RETURN TO NORMAL LIFE.

HOMELESS TO HOPE BENEFIT TELETHON

AIR DATE: MAY 3, 2020

GUEST: SANDY MORKEL...EXECUTIVE PRODUCER OF THE CITY OF CHARLESTON HOMELESS TO HOPE BENEFIT TELETHON, PRESIDENT OF THE CHARLESTON ROTARY CLUB, AND PRESIDENT OF THE ORGANIZATION CALLED 'SOLUTIONS FOR THE GREATER GOOD'.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CITY OF CHARLESTON'S 8 HOUR TELETHON MEANT TO RAISE MONEY TO HELP THE HOMELESS IN THE CITY. IT HAPPENS MAY 8TH 12 NOON THRU 8PM ON FACEBOOK...AND OTHER SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS.

THE EFFORT BEGAN IN 2016 AS ONE OF MAYOR JOHN TECKLENBURG'S OBJECTIVES. HE AND OTHERS WANT TO END HOMELESSNESS IN THE CITY.

IT WAS 4 YEARS AGO THE MAYOR AND OTHERS CLEARED OUT THE TENT CITY DOWNTOWN. HUNDREDS WERE LIVING IN TENTS UNDER THE OVERPASSES. THOSE RESIDENTS WERE TRANSFERRED TO ONE-80 PLACE FOR HELP IN FINDING SHELTER. TO THIS DAY...THE ONCE-TENT CITY AREA REMAINS CLEAR.

THE TELETHON WILL FEATURE LOTS OF LOCAL MUSICAL TALENTS PERFORMING IN THEIR HOMES ON SOCIAL MEDIA. VIEWERS ARE ASKED TO DONATE...IF THEY CAN...ANY AMOUNT TO HELP THE CITY'S HOMELESS.

MAYOR JOHN TECKLENBURG AND MT PLEASANT MAYOR WILL HAYNIE WILL ALSO PERFORM. TECKLENBURG PLAYS THE PIANO AND HAYNIE PLAYS GUITAR. MORKEL SAYS IT WILL BE FUN TO WATCH THEIR PERFORMANCES.

THE HOPE PROJECT CONTINUES TO SAVE PEOPLE FROM A LIKE OF
ADDICTION

AIRDATE: MAY 10, 2020

GUEST: CHAD LOGAN...CREATOR OF THE HOPE PROJECT OF
CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ONGOING PROBLEM OF ADDICTION
IN OUR SOCIETY. LOGAN STARTED THE HOPE PROJECT FOLLOWING
HIS RECOVERY AFTER 15 YEARS OF BEING ADDICTED TO DRUGS AND
ALCOHOL.

HE ADMITS THAT IT'S A PAINFUL PROCESS TO FREE YOURSELF FROM
ADDICTION. IT REQUIRES BEING VERY HONEST...DROPPING
RESENTMENTS...WANTING TO CHANGE YOUR LIFE. HE ALSO SAYS
RELAPSING IS QUITE COMMON AND IT MAY TAKE SEVERAL TIMES
BEFORE CHANGE HAPPENS.

MUCH LIKE ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS USES THE 12 STEP
PROGRAM...THE HOPE PROJECT SPECIFIES GOD INVOLVED IN
RECOVERY. A-A USES 'HIGHER POWER'. LOGAN SAYS IT IS AN
IMPORTANT PART OF RECOVERY TO SURRENDER.

DURING THESE TIMES OF SOCIAL DISTANCING DUE TO THE CORONA
VIRUS...THOSE ALL-IMPORTANT MEETINGS WITH OTHERS CANNOT
HAPPEN. BUT LOGAN SAYS THANKS TO SOCIAL MEDIA AND
STREAMING...MEETINGS HAVE BEEN HAPPENING VIRTUALLY. FOR
NOW THAT WILL HAVE TO DO. BUT HE DOES SAYS IN-PERSON
MEETINGS ARE MORE BENEFICIAL.

DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING...LOGAN SAYS MORE ON THOSE EARLY
IN RECOVERY HAVE REVERTED TO BAD HABITS AND USING AGAIN.
IT IS A DIFFICULT TIME FOR THOSE DEALING WITH ADDICTION.

HELPING FIRST RESPONDERS AND OTHERS DEALING WITH THE
EFFECTS OF THE CORONA VIRUS

AIR DATE: MAY 17, 2020

GUESTS: RICH ROBINSON...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE COASTAL
CRISIS CHAPLAINCY. DR YOULANDA GIBBS...FOUNDER AND
DIRECTOR OF THE PALMETTO PALACE

PART ONE OF THIS PROGRAM FEATURES THE WORK OF THE CRISIS
CHAPLAINCY AND THE WORK IT DOES TO HELP FIRST RESPONDERS
WHO ARE STILL DOING THEIR JOBS DURING THE VIRUS CRISIS.
ROBINSON SAYS OUR POLICE...FIRE...DEPUTY PERSONNEL...ARE
ALWAYS OUT THERE DOING THEIR JOBS IN TIMES OF CRISIS OR
EMERGENCY. THEY GIVE OF THEMSELVES WHILE RISKING
CONTRACTING THE CORONA VIRUS THEMSELVES. ROBINSON SAYS
HE HAS SPOKEN TO MANY OF THEM WHO ARE TRYING TO RELIEVE
THE USUAL STRESSES OF THE JOB....WHILE ALSO WORKING DURING
THE CRISIS.

PART TWO OF THE PROGRAM FEATURED THE WORK OF THE WOMAN
BEHIND SEVERAL EFFORTS. DR YOULANDA GIBBS STARTED THE
PALMETTO PALACE...WHICH WORKS TO SECURE HOTEL ROOMS AND
MEALS FOR VISITORS WHO MAY EXPERIENCE A MEDICAL
EMERGENCY WHILE VISITING THE LOW COUNTRY. HER
ORGANIZATION HAS PIVOTED TO PROVIDING A MOBILE HEALTH
UNIT THAT SERVICES THE RURAL AREAS. AND NOW...SHE HAS
PIVOTED AGAIN...STARTING A FOOD DISTRIBUTION EFFORT FOR
FAMILIES WHO HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO WORK DUE TO THE
VIRUS...BUT STILL HAVE FAMILIES TO FEED. HER WORK CAN BE
EXPLORED AT THE PALMETTO PALACE DOT COM.

CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER...WATCHING OVER OUR WATERWAYS

AIR DATE: MAY 24, 2020

GUEST: ANDREW WUNDERLEY...DIRECTOR OF CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER

DISCUSSION...VIA TELEPHONE...CENTERED ON THE UPCOMING MEMORIAL WEEKEND AND MORE RESIDENTS GETTING ON THE WATER IN THEIR BOATS. WUNDERLEY'S ORGANIZATION 'PATROLS' LOW COUNTRY CREEKS, MARSHES AND WATERWAYS LOOKING FOR TRASH AND POLLUTION.

WUNDERLEY SAYS OUR ECONOMY AND BEAUTY OF THE AREA DEPENDS ON THE HEALTH OF OUR WATERWAYS. AND HE SAYS THERE IS SO MUCH CHEMICAL RUNOFF IN THOSE WATERS. IT HAPPENS WHEN IT RAINS AND IT CAN'T REALLY BE HELPED. BUT HE SAYS IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP TABS ON THE HEALTH OF THESE NATURE AREAS.

HE SAYS VOLUNTEERS REALLY GET A 'REALITY CHECK' WHEN THEY SEE THE WATERWAYS UP CLOSE. THEY REALIZE THE BEAUTY OF THESE AREAS...BUT THEY ALSO SEE THE ABUSE. TRASH IS ALSO DUMPED INTO OUR WATERWAYS AND THE ACTIONS HURT WILDLIFE AND RUINS THE BEAUTY OF THESE WATERWAYS.

HE SAYS THE WAR AGAINST 'NERDLES' CONTINUE. THESE ARE SMALL PLASTIC PELLETS THAT GET CARELESSLY SPILLED AT OUR PORT. THEY SPREAD OUT AND GET INTO OUR WATERWAYS. LAWSUITS HAVE BEEN LODGED AGAINST THOSE RESPONSIBLE...BUT PROSECUTION OF THESE CASES PROVE TO BE SLIPPERY.

EFFORTS CONTINUE TO SAFEGUARD THE HEALTH OF WATERWAYS.

FORECASTING THE 2020 ATLANTIC HURRICANE SEASONAIR DATE: MAY 31, 2020

GUEST: DAVE WILLIAMS...CHIEF METEOROLOGIST AT WCIV...ABC NEWS 4...AND OUR CUMULUS MEDIA TV PARTNER

DISCUSSION WAS A SPIRITED LOOK AT THE HURRICANE SEASON...WHICH STARTS MONDAY JUNE FIRST. THE CONVERSATION STARTED WITH A LOOK AT WHAT HAS BEEN AN ACTIVE SPRING STORM SEASON. THE LOW COUNTRY HAS SEEN SEVERAL STRONG LINES OF THUNDERSTORMS THAT HAVE PRODUCED STRONG DAMAGING WINDS AND EVEN EF-1 LEVEL TORNADOS.

THE ACTIVE SPRING MAY BE A LOOK INTO WHAT HAS BEEN FORECAST TO BE AN ABOVE-NORMAL HURRICANE SEASON. WILLIAMS SAYS WE SHOULD EXPECT MORE NAMED STORMS AND MORE HURRICANE ACTIVITY IN THE ATLANTIC.

WILLIAMS SAYS TECHNOLOGY HAS BEEN THE KEY TO MORE ACCURATE FORECASTING OF STORMS. IT CAN EVEN TELL US WHAT NEIGHBORHOOD MAY BE THREATENED BY A TORNADO.

WILLIAMS HAS BEEN UP WITH THE HURRICANE HUNTERS. THEY FLY INTO STORMS TO CHECK DETAILS. HE SAYS THAT FORECASTING HURRICANES COULD BECOME EVEN BETTER IF THERE COULD BE MORE ACCURATE INFORMATION ON HOW STORMS ACTUALLY FORM. HE SAYS WILL MIGHT BE DONE SOMEDAY USING SATELLITES...BUT RIGHT NOW IT IS NOT POSSIBLE.

UNDERSTANDING RACE IN THE WAKE OF THE MINNEAPOLIS KILLING
OF GEORGE FLOYD

AIR DATE: JUNE 7, 2020

GUEST: ELMIRE RAVEN...NON-PROFIT CONSULTANT...FORMER EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 'MY SISTER'S HOUSE', A SHELTER FOR BATTERED WOMEN...AND A FORMER LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

DISCUSSION WAS MEANT TO BE ANOTHER STEP TOWARD UNDERSTANDING RACE DIFFERENCES IN AMERICA. ELMIRE RAVEN RELATED STORIES OF HER EXPERIENCES AS A BLACK WOMAN. I IMAGINE HER AGE IS SOMEWHERE IN HER 60s...SO SHE HAS SEEN A LOT...ESPECIALLY AS A BLACK WOMEN IN LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE 1970s.

SHE SAYS THE MINNEAPOLIS KILLING OF GEORGE FLOYD WAS SHOCKING TO EVERYONE SHE KNOWS...AND THAT THE MINORITY COMMUNITY WANTS TO SEE JUSTICE. WILL THE COMMUNITY BE SATISFIED WITH ANY VERDICT? SHE SAYS THOSE SHE HAS TALKED TO WANT HIM IN PRISON FOR LIFE. THE LAW...AS WRITTEN...HOWEVER MAY NOT REQUIRE THAT.

AS FOR THE PROTESTS...RAVEN SAYS ANY PROTEST MUST BE PEACEFUL AND AGREES THAT WHEN VANDALS AND LOOTERS CO-OP PEACEFUL PROTESTS...IT GIVES BLACK AMERICANS A BAD NAME.

SHE BELIEVES THAT IF EVERYONE SIMPLY TREATED EACH OTHER WITH GENERAL RESPECT...LIFE IN AMERICA WOULD BE A LOT DIFFERENT. SHE ADMITS IT SOUNDS SIMPLE...BUT IT IS NOT...DUE TO THE DIFFERENT INFLUENCES WE'VE ALL EXPERIENCED.

EDISTO ISLAND LAND TRUST PRESERVES THRU A 'PARTY ON YOUR PORCH' FUNDRAISER

GUEST: JOHN GIRAULT...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EDISTO ISLAND OPEN LAND TRUST

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE PRESERVATION OF EDISTO ISLAND...A SMALL A RURAL WATERFRONT AREA IN CHARLESTON COUNTY. THE OPEN LAND TRUST WORKS WITH MANY PRESERVATION GROUPS AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN AN EFFORT TO KEEP IT FROM BECOMING A MINI MYRTLE BEACH.

THE LAND TRUST IS AN EFFORT THAT WORKS WITH LAND OWNERS TO INSURE THAT SOME OF THESE REMOTE AREAS REMAIN AS PRISTINE AS POSSIBLE. THE LAND TRUST'S ORIGINS 25 YEARS AGO WAS LAUNCHED AFTER A DEVELOPER SAW EDISTO AS A GOLD MINE FOR A NEW DEVELOPMENT. IT WAS STOPPED.

GIRAULT SAYS THE LAND TRUST DOESN'T WANT TO TOTALLY LOCK DOWN THE AREA TO EVERYONE. BUT THE OPEN LAND TRUST DOES WORK TO PRESERVE AS MUCH OF THE AREA AS POSSIBLE.

DUE TO THE CORONA VIRUS...THE LAND TRUST IS HOLDING A THREE DAY ONLINE FUNDRAISER CALLED 'THE PARTY ON YOUR PORCH'. IT'S A THREE DAY ONLINE AUCTION OF ITEMS RANGING FROM CRAFTS TO VACATION TRIPS. THERE WILL ALSO BE PRIZES FOR SENDING IN 'PARTY ON YOUR PORCH' PHOTOGRAPHS OF ONLINE AUCTION PARTICIPANTS.

I SERVE WITH JOY...THE INSPIRATION TO HELP OTHERS

AIR DATE: JUNE 21, 2020

GUEST: JOY CAMPBELL...FOUNDER OF THE LOCAL NON PROFIT KNOWN AS 'I SERVE WITH JOY'.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON CAMPBELL'S THREE YEAR OLD ORGANIZATION THAT HAS REACHED OUT TO HELP STUDENTS...THE HOMELESS...AND THE HUNGRY IN THE AREA.

CAMPBELL SAYS HER INSPIRATION TO REACH OUT TO OTHERS IS TRULY A LOCAL STORY. WHEN SHE WAS A KID SHE WORKED WITH THE LATE TONY THE PEANUT MAN. LATER IN LIFE SHE KNEW AND WORKED WITH TWO VICTIMS OF THE CHARLESTON CHURCH SHOOTINGS. SHE SAYS ALL THOSE PEOPLE ALONG WITH THE WAY SHE WAS RAISED...HELPED HER ON THIS PATH OF HELPING OTHERS.

THE I-SERVE-WITH-JOY EFFORT WAS CHALLENGED BY THE CORONA VIRUS. CAMPBELL REALIZED THAT THE UNEMPLOYED SUDDENLY HAD NO MONEY TO BUY FOOD. SO CAMPBELL WORKED WITH SUPERMARKETS AND THE LOW COUNTRY FOOD BANK TO FILL BAGS WITH FOOD FOR NEEDY FAMILIES.

AND CAMPBELL STARTED A PROGRAM CALLED HERO HUGS. FOR DOLLAR DONATIONS...CAMPBELL SENDS FIRST RESPONDERS 'HUGS' FROM THOSE IN THE COMMUNITY WHO ARE GRATEFUL FOR THEIR EFFORTS DURING COVID-19. THIS INCLUDED MEDIAL STAFFS...POLICE....FIREFIGHTERS AND OTHER FIRST RESPONDERS.

CAMPBELL SAYS THAT AS TIME GOES BY...SHE HOPES TO DO MORE TO HELP THOSE WHO NEED IT.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON CHRIS AND HIS EXPERIENCES IN THE 5
YEARS SINCE A GUNMAN SHOT TO DEATH 9 MEMBERS OF THE
CHURCH FOLLOWING A BIBLE STUDY CLASS. IT HAPPENED JUNE 17,
2015.

CHRIS' MOTHER WAS ONE OF THE SHOOTING VICTIMS. CHRIS SAYS
THOUGH HE STILL CHOKES UP A BIT TALKING ABOUT THAT
LOSS...HE SAYS HE IS ABLE TO TALK ABOUT IT BECAUSE HIS FAITH
HAS GROWN A LOT OVER THE LAST 5 YEARS.

CHRIS HAS BECOME AN INSPIRATIONAL SPEAKER...TALKING TO
CORPORATIONS...CHURCH GROUPS....AND STUDENTS ALL OVER THE
U-S. HE SAYS HE TRIES TO SPREAD THE MESSAGE OF HOPE AND
LOVE. AND HE TALKS ABOUT GOD...A LOT.

CHRIS SAYS DESPITE THE UNSPEAKABLE TRAUMA HE SUFFERED
LOSING HIS MOM IS SUCH A PUBLIC WAY...HE SAYS HE HAS GROWN
AND MAY BE EVEN A BETTER PERSON. HE SAYS HE'S LEARNED
HOW GRACE HAS WORKED IN HIS LIFE....MARRIAGE...AND IN HIS
WORK.

CHRIS SAYS HE DOES MISS PLAYING BASEBALL....BUT HE IS STILL
CLOSE TO IT THRU HIS JOB WITH THE RIVERDOGS.

HE HAS ALSO JUST COME OUT WITH A BOOK ENTITLED 'DIFFERENT'.
IT TEACHES KIDS THAT WE ARE ALL DIFFERENT AND DIFFERENCES
MAKE THE WORLD MORE INTERESTING.
