KNTV/NBC BAY AREA is responsive to the principal issues arising in its community through regularly scheduled public affairs programming, newscasts, public service announcements as well as documentaries and specials. The following is a list of some of the programs that have provided the station's most significant treatment of community issues during the preceding three-month period.

### **BUSINESS & INDUSTRY, EMPLOYMENT**

#### **NBC BAY AREA, THE BAY AREA TODAY 6:00PM-7:00PM 10/1/18 REPORTED...**

AUDIT THE DMV – REPEATEDLY. THAT'S WHAT GAS TAX OPPONENTS AND REPUBLICAN LAWMAKERS ARE NOW DEMANDING. SEVERAL PEOPLE LOOKING TO REPEAL THE STATE'S GAS TAX MET TODAY IN SACRAMENTO. LAST MONTH, GOVERNOR BROWN CALLED FOR A STATE AUDIT OF THE AGENCY TO CRACK DOWN ON LONG WAIT TIMES, REGISTRATION ERRORS, AND SYSTEM OUTAGES. THIS GROUP SAYS THAT ISN'T ENOUGH AND SAY THE AGENCY HAS GROSSLY MISMANAGED ITS BUDGET. THEY WANT AN INDEPENDENT AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT EVERY THREE YEARS.

A PAY RAISE FOR AMAZON EMPLOYEES. THE COMPANY SAYS IT'S RAISING THE MINIMUM WAGE TO 15 DOLLARS AN HOUR FOR ALL U.S. EMPLOYEES. IT'S A MOVE THAT WILL BENEFIT 250 THOUSAND FULL TIME WORKERS. THOSE WHO ARE ALREADY MAKING 15 DOLLARS AN HOUR WILL GET A PAY BUMP TOO. THIS ALL STARTS IN NOVEMBER.

#### **NBC BAY AREA, THE BAY AREA TODAY 6:00PM-7:00PM 10/3/18 REPORTED...**

WE'RE LEARNING TONIGHT THAT ELON MUSK INITIALLY "BALKED" AT THE SETTLEMENT TESLA REACHED WITH FEDERAL REGULATORS LAST WEEK. THE SEC HAD FILED SUIT AGAINST MUSK, ACCUSING HIM OF FRAUD. CNBC REPORTS MUSK ACTUALLY THREATENED TO QUIT WHEN HE WAS TOLD THE SEC DEMANDED HE STEP DOWN AS CHAIRMAN AS PART OF A SETTLEMENT. THE FRAUD CHARGES STEMMED FROM MUSK'S TWEET THAT HE WAS CONSIDERING TAKING THE COMPANY PRIVATE. MUSK WAS BOTH THE COMPANY'S CEO AND CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD. ULTIMATELY MUSK ACCEPTED THE SETTLEMENT WITH THE SEC ACTUALLY ADDING A THIRD YEAR TO HIS BAN AS CHAIRMAN. MUSK REMAINS THE COMPANY'S CEO.

A GLOBAL PHARMACEUTICAL GIANT IS MAKING CUTBACKS AND IT'S IMPACTING THE BAY AREA. BAYER PHARMACEUTICALS SAYS IT'S LAYING OFF MORE THAN 200 EMPLOYEES AT ITS PLANT IN BERKELEY. IN A STATEMENT, BAYER SAYS THE LAYOFFS COME AS IT TRANSITIONING ITS PRODUCTS AND THAT'S RESULTING IN A NEED TO CUT BACK IN SOME AREAS. BERKELEY HAS BEEN BAYER'S BIOTECHNOLOGY MANUFACTURING HUB FOR MORE THAN 40 YEARS.

ALSO IN THE BAY AREA, CUTBACKS AT ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR BREWERIES. LAGUNITAS BREWING COMPANY ANNOUNCED IT'S CUTTING ITS WORKFORCE BY 12 PERCENT. THE BREWERY, FOUNDED IN PETALUMA, HAS ABOUT 900 EMPLOYEES. IT WAS RECENTLY PURCHASED BY HEINEKEN. LAGUNITAS SAYS THE DECISION TO DOWNSIZE IS DUE TO DECLINING SALES AND MORE COMPETITORS ENTERING THE MARKET.

DAYS AFTER HE WAS FINED AND DEMOTED, TESLA FOUNDER, ELON MUSK TODAY TAUNTED THE FEDERAL COMMISSION THAT DISCIPLINED HIM. HIS TWEET RENAMED THE SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION THE "SHORTSELLER ENRICHMENT COMMISSION." HE ENGAGED THE TWITTER FOLLOWERS WHO QUESTIONED HIS JUDGMENT, DOUBLING-DOWN ON HIS INSULT. NOT ONLY DID THE SEC REQUIRE MUSK TO STEP DOWN FROM HIS JOB AS CHAIRMAN FOR THREE YEARS LEADING HIS COMPANY, TESLA WAS ALSO ORDERED TO CURB MUSK'S COMMUNICATIONS. THAT'S BECAUSE IT WAS TWITTER THAT GOT MUSK IN TROUBLE WHEN HE TWEETED HE WAS TAKING THE COMPANY PRIVATE.

IT'S NOT CLEAR AT WHAT POINT IN THE MANUFACTURING PROCESS THE TINY CHINESE SURVEILLANCE CHIPS WERE EMBEDDED INTO SERVER MOTHERBOARDS. SUPER MICRO, BASED IN SAN JOSE, MAKES THOSE MOTHERBOARDS, AND DENIES THE REPORT, FROM BLOOMBERG NEWS. SUPER-MICRO'S STOCK PLUNGED 40 PERCENT TODAY. ITS HARDWARE IS USED BY THE U.S. GOVERNMENT AND MAJOR COMPANIES INCLUDING APPLE AND AMAZON. APPLE SAYS IT HASN'T FOUND "MALICIOUS CHIPS OR "HARDWARE MANIPULATIONS." AMAZON ALSO DENIED FINDING ANY HARDWARE ISSUES.

IT'S NO SECRET THE HIGH COST OF LIVING IS FORCING MORE AND MORE PEOPLE TO MOVE AWAY. NOW A DUBIOUS DISTINCTION, THE BAY AREA HAS THE HIGHEST INCOME DISPARITY OF ANY MAJOR METROPOLITAN AREA. THAT'S ACCORDING TO A NEW STUDY BY UC BERKELEY RESEARCHERS. THEY LOOKED AT INCOMES OF PEOPLE MOVING IN AND OUT OF THE AREA BETWEEN 2010 AND 2016. FOR EVERY ONE PERSON MOVING INTO THE AREA WITH AN ANNUAL INCOME OF 200 THOUSAND DOLLARS PLUS, SIX PEOPLE UNDER THE 100 THOUSAND DOLLAR MARK MOVED OUT. RESEARCHERS SAY MOST OF THOSE PEOPLE LEAVING ARE MINORITY WORKERS. AND THAT IMPACTS BUSINESSES WHO ARE STRUGGLING TO FIND PEOPLE WILLING TO WORK BLUE COLLAR JOBS.

TOMORROW YOU CAN EXPECT A TEXT FROM PRESIDENT TRUMP. THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, OR FEMA, IS TESTING A NEW WAY TO NOTIFY AMERICANS ACROSS THE COUNTRY IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY. IT'S CALLED A PRESIDENTIAL ALERT AND YOU'RE GOING TO GET ONE TOMORROW MORNING. IT'LL READ, "PRESIDENTIAL ALERT. THIS IS A TEST. NO ACTION IS REQUIRED." IT USES GPS TO HELP IDENTIFY YOUR LOCATION AND OFFERS DROPDOWN MENUS TO ANSWER KEY QUESTIONS. MILLER SAYS HIS GOAL ISN'T TO UNDERMINE THE CITY'S REPORTING SYSTEM. HE JUST WANTS TO SIMPLIFY IT. THE CITY'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT SAYS THE CITY AVERAGES 10,000 CLEANING REQUESTS PER MONTH. ABOUT 1,300 ARE RELATED TO HUMAN OR ANIMAL WASTE.

INSTEAD, THE LAWSUIT SAYS TESTING REVEALED THE DRINKS CONTAIN CHEMICALS, SOME OF WHICH ARE FOUND IN COCKROACH INSECTICIDE. LA CROIX MANUFACTURERS DENIED THE ALLEGATIONS. THEY SAY THE FLAVORS COME FROM NATURAL ESSENCE OILS STRAIGHT FROM FRUIT.

ZHOU SUED THE CITY CLAIMING THE PARKS DEPARTMENT DIDN'T PROPERLY MAINTAIN THE TREES. THE TREE WAS A CANARY PINE AND THE CITY HAS REMOVED ALL OF THOSE FROM THE PARK.

THE FORMER CEO OF YAHOO IS OUTLINING HER PLANS TO BREATHE NEW LIFE INTO AN OLD FUNERAL HOME. MARISSA MAYER BOUGHT THE BUILDING ON MIDDLEFIELD ROAD IN PALO ALTO BACK IN 2013. SHE WANTS TO TURN IT INTO A COMMUNITY CENTER FOR WORKING WOMEN AND THEIR FAMILIES. SHE CALLS IT THE CORNER HOUSE. IN ORDER FOR THE PLAN TO BECOME A REALITY THE CITY HAS TO REZONE THE PROPERTY. MAYER SPOKE TO THE CITY COUNCIL LAST NIGHT ABOUT HOW THE CENTER WOULD BENEFIT THE COMMUNITY. IF THE CITY APPROVES THE PLAN MEMBERSHIP WOULD RUN ABOUT 200 DOLLARS A MONTH.

YOU MAY REMEMBER THAT NBC BAY AREA'S INVESTIGATIVE REPORTER JAXON VAN DERBEKEN FIRST REPORTED ABOUT THE ACCUSATIONS INVOLVING FIRE STATION NUMBER TWO. ACCORDING TO THE FEDERAL LAWSUIT, SUZANNE MONTES SAYS HER MALE COUNTERPARTS SHUNNED AND RETALIATED AGAINST HER AFTER SHE LANDED A COVETED JOB STAFFING A FIRE TRUCK. WHILE NO ONE WAS DISCIPLINED, THERE WAS A SHAKEUP OF STAFF AT THE STATION AND SOME ADDITIONAL TRAINING.

AT FIRST HE CLAIMED SELF-DEFENSE, THEN LATER CUT A DEAL WITH PROSECUTORS AND PLEADED NO-CONTEST TO VOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER.

THIS YEAR'S WINNERS OF NOBEL PEACE PRIZE ARE FIGHTING TO END THE USE OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE AS A WEAPON OF WAR. DENNIS MUKWEGE IS A CONGOLESE GYNECOLOGIST. HE FOUNDED AND RUNS A HOSPITAL THAT SPECIALIZES IN TREATING SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN THE CONGO - A COUNTRY THAT HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS THE WORST PLACES ON EARTH TO BE A WOMAN. THE OTHER WINNER, NADIA MURAD, IS A HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVIST. SHE SURVIVED AN ISLAMIC STATE MASSACRE AND WAS TORTURED AND RAPED BY ISIS MILITANTS. SHE THEN LED A WORLDWIDE CAMPAIGN TO RECOGNIZE THE GENOCIDE OF THE YAZIDI PEOPLE. BOTH WINNERS DEDICATED THEIR AWARDS TO VICTIMS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE WORLDWIDE.

A SAN JOSE DENTIST BELIEVES SHE'S BEEN TARGETED WITH A HATE CRIME, AFTER DISCOVERING RACIST GRAFFITI IN HER PARKING LOT. DR. MOHSENA AHMAD FOUND THE VANDALISM THIS MORNING. A SWASTIKA AND WHAT APPEARS TO BE THE LETTERS KKK. IT HAPPENED JUST THREE DAYS AFTER SHE PUT UP A SIGN ON HER OFFICE AT CAMDEN AND UNION AVENUES. AROUND 6 THIS MORNING, SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS CAPTURED A MAN WEARING A PATRIOTIC SHIRT WITH THE WORD USA ACROSS IT. SAN JOSE POLICE ARE NOT CALLING THE MAN A SUSPECT AT THIS TIME, BUT THEY ARE INVESTIGATING THE VANDALISM AS A HATE CRIME. THE COUNCIL ON AMERICAN-ISLAMIC RELATIONS SAYS THERE HAS BEEN AN UPTICK IN HATE CRIMES AGAINST MUSLIMS IN THE BAY AREA DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS.

YOU CAN SEE IN THIS DASH CAM VIDEO THE BUS HIT A MEDIAN ON LOMBARD STREET THEN CAREENED INTO A TREE. PASSENGERS ONLY SUFFERED MINOR INJURIES.
