We were on hand to help open the event as well as providing a two hour broadcast for the kick off....We also promoted the event with on air mentions and public service announcements prior to the start...

We broadcast live from 11am till 1pm inviting listneners to stop by and see the available pets for adoption, enjoy the food and dunk tank. There were also activities for children form face painting to coloring and temporary tattoos...We supported the broadcast through a series of on air promos.

On August 28 Gus Harmeyer was an in studio guest talking about the upcoming Historic Elmhurst Fish Fry. Elmhurst holds the event annually to raise funds for the upkeep of the historic property.
