THE ORDER OF APPEARANCE DOES NOT REFLECT PRIORITY OR SIGNIFICANCE.

THIS SECOND QUARTER OF THE YEAR INCLUDED ISSUES SUCH AS CONTINUED COVERAGE OF THE BICENTENNIAL OR 200TH BIRTHDAY OF THE CITY OF CONNERSVILLE. MANY EVENTS WILL BE TAKING PLACE ALL YEAR LONG AND WIFE RADIO IS AN ACTIVE PARTICIPANT. OTHER ISSUES THIS QUARTER INCLUDED A POTENTIAL DISASTER WHEN A TANKER TRUCK OVERTURNED NEAR CONNERSVILLE CAUSING EVACUATIONS AND ROAD CLOSURE FOR SEVERAL DAYS: THE HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN THE AREA AND THE OVERALL ECONOMY; A SPECIAL FUND RAISER CONDUCTED BY THE HOSPITAL TO HELP SEVERAL HIGH SCHOOL ORGANIZATIONS; AND FREE FOOD DISTRIBUTION AND SUMMER FREE LUNCH PROGRAMS

DESCRIPTION: WHEN A TANKER TRUCK LOADED WITH THOUSANDS OF GALLONS OF PAINT THINNER OVERTURNED ON STATE ROAD 44 AT THE EDGE OF CONNERSVILLE SEVERAL HOMES WERE EVACUATED AND THE ROAD WAS CLOSED. A LARGE QUANTITY OF THE MATERIAL LEAKED OUT OF THE TRUCK AND SOAKED INTO THE SOIL.
