III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. Management Training:

1. The Salem Vice President of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via teleconference and Powerpoint presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Business Manager participates in these training sessions each month and then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the company and the SEU's policy on equal employment.

B. Job Banks

1. The SEU Participates in media related job banks and internet programs designed to provide general information about opportunities in broadcasting and to encourage individuals to consider future employment. During this reporting period, certain job posting we posted to the following job bank:

C. Events with Educational Institutions:

- On air host conducts broadcasting seminars for juniors at Waynesburg University, West Virginia. Students were taught about writing, announcing, and reporting for TV & radio and hosting a live talk show and broadcasting opportunities in the industry. Students were assigned projects that included their own on-air performance.
- 2. Audio/Video/Digital Producer spoke with Mount Vernon Nazarene University Intro to Radio Class. Discussed the work they did, being in broadcasting and gave advice and ideas to get into the broadcasting field.

D. Other Outreach Activities:

1. The Creative Director conducted a station tour & discussion on Bring Your Child to Work Day. They met with the General Manager, Chief Engineer, & Production Director. Topics discussed were national spot fulfillment, National versus Local programming, technological changes, digital versus broadcast, The Chief Engineer discussed basics of studio to tower to listener and the role of computers. The General Manager discussed Public Policy in the industry such as the Fairness Doctrine, Telecommunications Act of 1996 and how these affect content and business of the local stations.
