

BYRON CENTER, MI – Every summer, Railside Golf Club owner, manager and PGA Professional Jim Bultema becomes a marathon man to support the women's and children's programs at Mel Trotter Ministries.

He teed it up for 36 consecutive hours Sunday and Monday with help from local celebrities to raise funds and awareness as part of the 16th annual Golf Marathon of Hope that raised about \$100,000.



Bultema, 36, partnered with several local celebrities again this time.

He played nine-hole rounds with former Mr. Basketball Award winners Matt Steigenga and Drew Neitzel, former NFL and Michigan State players Mitch Lyons and Ty Hallock, WOOD-TV 8's Terri DeBoer, WLAV-FM's Tony Gates, WBBL-FM's Bill Simonson and others in an alternate-shot format.

He played a total of 342 holes, beginning at 7 a.m. Sunday and continuing through 7 p.m. Monday. His only breaks were a half-hour soaking under a hot shower at from 4:30 a.m. to 5 a.m. on Monday morning and a short lunch break between shotgun starts of morning and afternoon squads for the Mei Trotter golf outing.

"My body feels really good," he said early Monday afternoon. "The part that always hurts the most is the hands. I like to interact with all of the celebrities. If I was by myself doing this, it wouldn't be any fun."

"It was a supernatural feat of endurance. We are so grateful to Jim for showing compassion to the hungry, homeless and hurting by participating in our Golf Marathon year after year," said Rev. Chico Daniels, Mel Trotter's president and CEO.

Brian Diemer of Calvin College, who won the bronze medal in the 3,000-meter steeplechase during the 1984 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles, posted the lowest score among the celebrities with a 32.

The Michigan Colorectal Cancer Early Detection Program

- The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) has implemented the Michigan Colorectal Cancer Early Detection Program (MCRCEDP) through a multi-year grant from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The MCRCEDP provides outreach and colorectal cancer education, individualized risk assessment, and screening to eligible 50- to 64-year-old men and women living in 38 Michigan counties
- MCRCEDP services are provided through eight local coordinating agencies (LCAs) with the cooperation and partnership of physicians, hospitals, and other health care organizations in their communities. Following Michigan Cancer Consortium Guidelines for the Early Detection of Colorectal Cancer, colorectal cancer screening is provided through:
 - · Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) for average-risk clients, and
 - · Colonoscopy for clients at increased risk for colorectal cancer.



KidsFirst Emergency Shelter

Since 1998, the St. John's Campus has provided emergency shelter services for Kent County boys and girls. Last year, 452 Kent County children, from newborns to 17, stayed for a short time in two comfortable homes, called "KidsFirst".

Always Open.

Each day battered and neglected children and adolescents are brought to KidsFirst's door by public safety officers or Protective Services workers. They stay until a safe home can be found. KidsFirst serves nearly 600 children each year.

A Nurturing Staff.

Kids' needs come first. Injuries and trauma are the first concern, followed by home-cooked meals, warm baths, clean clothing and even a teddy bear. Counselors are always ready to listen and give reassurance.

New Experiences.

During their stay, kids enjoy St. John's 25-acre campus—including cookouts, bike rides, basketball, and crafts.

A Partnership.

The KidsFirst program is at the center of child welfare in Kent County—serving 600 abused and neglected kids each year, and partnering with the Kent County Department of Human Services and all other child welfare agencies serving the county.

You can help!

During their stay, kids attend plays, sporting events, concerts and festivals—sometimes for the very first time in their lives—thanks to donated tickets and passes. These new opportunities show children that the community values them and wants to contribute to their care.

Michigan Indoor Radon Program Overview

The Michigan Indoor Radon Program is a non-regulatory program. Its purpose is to incelevated indoor radon levels, to encourage testing for radon, and to also encourage citizens are found. The program resides in the Radiological Protection Section of the Resource M Quality.




