

QUARTERLY ISSUES & PROGRAMS LIST

There follows a listing of some of the most significant issues responded to by station WHTT-FM, Buffalo, New York, along with the most significant programming treatment those issues for the period July 1, 2021 through July 31, 2021. The listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority. The issues were covered on WHTT-FM's public affairs program on the dates indicated. The program is 30 minutes long and begins at 8am on Sundays.

ISSUE: Willie Price Speaks

DATE: July 4, 2021

DURATION: 28:00

DESCRIPTION:

Speaker, author and trainer discussed his programs sudden 'halt' due to the pandemic and how he even began to organize his thoughts enough to figure out how to help he and his programs not only continue, but get BETTER throughout the pandemic. He also discusses his program more in depth and how his lessons for young men can be even MORE useful now after such a trying time. They discuss a few of his books, including a newer one, as well as the impact his writing and programs have had, before, during and as we head out of the pandemic.

ISSUE: Niagara County Sheriff's Department

DATE: July 11, 2021

DURATION: 28:00

DESCRIPTION:

Niagara County Sheriff Mike J. Filicetti joined the program to discuss the recent declaration of emergency by NY Gov Cuomo due to increase in gun violence. The Sheriff helps make sense of what this means and why this may have had to be done in order to move towards improvement in keeping streets safe. He also discussed other ways in which communities can help determine and hold people accountable in order to decrease violence, more specifically with guns. His expertise helped to put into perspective what we are seeing and hearing about, as well as humanize the effort to keep our communities safe.

ISSUE: Specialty Substance Abuse Disorders & Services

DESCRIPTION:

Matt Smith, Executive Director of Prevention Focus and Ty Polk VP of Specialty Substance Abuse Disorders & Services facilitated a discussion about drug use, abuse and awareness given the circumstances this past 17 months of the pandemic. They talked about the increased rates of abuse and acknowledged and

tried to make sense of the rise in drug use/abuse in relation to the pandemic. They also got into the impact the topic as a whole has on children, directly and indirectly. They provided information about their organizations and how they can help as well as contact info and other details of the services they provide.

ISSUE: NYS Troopers

DATE: July 25, 2021

DESCRIPTION:

NYS Trooper Jim O'Callahan, also Officer of Public Information discussed the changes and upticks in many areas of concern regarding the roadways and the tone on the roads as we emerge from the pandemic, where obviously less people were on the roads. He mentions that a lot of the trends they are seeing as more people get back out are alarming and he provided details and ways to avoid befalling these mistakes on the road in order to make in safer here in WNY and NYS. He also talked about recruitment for the force and how to get information and get involved if this career interests you.

ISSUE: Niagara Hospice

Martina Fern, Director of Philanthropic Giving, Niagara Hospice joined to discuss how they impact the community and those who need hospice by constantly collecting donations and attempting to make tough situations easier for families and loved ones. She discusses the world-wide impact of Hospice and touches on the fact that they are in many countries, not just the US. Martina also delves into the personal impact Hospice has had in her life, as well as how COVID has affected their efforts and whether there were any issues with staff being vaccinated or not as they move forward with their work.

ISSUE: Vision Possible Concert Event

Ji Hoon Choi & panel from Vision Possible Concert Event, 440 Project joined to talk about the impact of music on a community, especially in the US and even here locally. They provided details on their upcoming fundraiser concert and some of the influence this event has had. They told of the origins of the organization and its evolution, as well as how so many musicians came to be a part of it and help make the event what it is today. Joe Demarco of Wings Flights of Hope stopped on to briefly recap/discuss his recent, annual charity event that takes place right behind the Bills Stadium and helps raise money for this incredible charity organization he founded. He detailed the ways in which this FREE flight service assists patients and individuals/families in times of need, who may not be able to get that treatment anywhere else, or to even get to the treatment facility. Joe told some great, inspiring stories to highlight the impact this VOLUNTARY, FREE service has on families & individuals, which can take them anywhere they need for medical care!
