Eye On Veterans

Broadcast on 10-22-2023 at 6:00AM; Duration: 60 min. This week we take a deep look into the Israel-Hamas war through the eyes of a combat veteran and author with decades of experience fighting terrorism. Brad Taylor is a former Special Forces Officer and led the Army's most elite unit, 1st Special Forces Operational Detachment Delta aka Delta Force. But more than tactical experience, his knowledge of Hamas, Hezbollah and other militant groups stems from years of research as a best-selling author. Throughout this hour Taylor explains; the backstory to this violent conflict, the other players like Hezbollah and Iran and why Palestinians in Gaza elected a known terrorist organization for their leadership.

Segment 1: We lead off with an important update on lung cancer screening for veterans from Dr Chris Slaytore (Slay-tore) Chief Consultant, National Center for Lung Cancer Screening, at the Veterans Health Administration.

Segment 2: We investigate another side of the Israel-Hamas War raging in Gaza through the eye of a veteran who was an advisor to the Joint Chiefs of Staff during the Iraq War. In a recent op ed, former Command Chief Master Sergeant of the Air Force, Dennis Fritz called out those in Congress who favor an escalation of fighting in Gaza, and even call for attacks on Iran. He calls for the US to be a true peace maker in the region, assist efforts to broker peace between Israel and the Palestinian people and why US leaders should not be looking to escalate this fight.

Segment 3: Fritz explains how dangerous it would be for political leaders to call for US military action.

Segment 4: We discuss the most difficult part of efforts to negotiate peace between Israelis and Palestinians, who are currently ruled by Hamas, a well-known and barbaric terrorist organization.
