CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purposes of creating a corporation, not organized for profit, pursuant to Chapter 6 of Title 29 of the District of Columbia Code, do hereby adopt the following Certificate of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. - The name of this corporation shall be:
The Greater Washington Educational Television Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II. - The term for which the corporation is organized shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.- The purpose and object of this corporation shall be to furnish a non-profit and non-commercial educational television broadcast service to the Greater Washington Area and to make available to the educational and cultural institutions and organizations willing to provide suitable television programs the necessary physical facilities and operational staff. To that end, the corporation shall be empowered to obtain and to hold appropriate Authorizations from the Federal Communications Commission; to construct, operate and maintain a non-commercial educational television station used primarily for transmitting educational, cultural and entertainment programs and for serving the educational needs of the community, pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission governing non-commercial educational television stations; to obtain or to hold by contribution, deed or lease real or personal property and funds to be used in connection with the operation of its television station; and to solicit and accept, in trust or otherwise, money and property to be used for these purposes. This corporation will not conduct business for profit. No part of the net earnings of this corporation will inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of the activities will be to carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt, to influence legislation.

ARTICLE IV. - The number of Trustees for the first year of the corporation's existence shall be eighteen (18).

ARTICLE V. - The principal office of the corporation shall be in Washington, D. C.

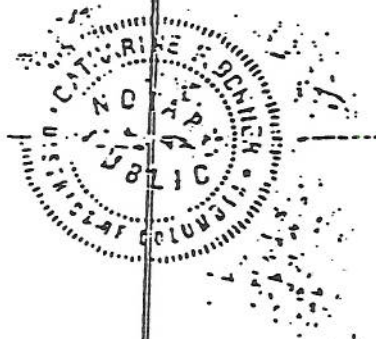

Pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Code, § 29-604, the undersigned adopts the following Article of Amendment to its Certificate of Incorporation:

The name of the corporation is Greater Washington Educational Television Association, Inc.

The following amendment to the Certificate of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation in the manner prescribed by the District of Columbia Code, § 29-604:

Add to Article III

"In the event of the dissolution or termination the remaining assets of the corporation will be distributed exclusively for the educational or exempt purposes specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954."

The above amendment was adopted by the consent in writing
