Desantis has called on Florida's Department of Education to limit how objections to books are made in schools. On Thursday, Desantis said he wants a legislative solution that would limit the book challenge process. He also debunked a "false narrative" that

					Florida bans books. The request comes less than a year after Desantis signed a bill that removed hundreds of books from school libraries.

The spill led to the biggest environmental settlement ever, 20 billion dollars. Florida's Triumph Gulf Coast Board was appointed to approve and oversee the distribution of that money for the recovery of the eight Northwest Florida counties affected. A newly published report is highlighting Escambia County's success in putting millions of that money to work.</p>

Tonight, the Senate passed a short-term spending bill. It passed in the House this afternoon. Once signed by the President, the measures will fund some government agencies for another week, through March 8 th , and others until March 22 nd . It's the fourth such extension since November. But this time, Congressional leaders are promising to finalize a full spending agreement before the second deadline.

Health experts are encouraging everyone to get a flu shot since we are in peak season for the flu.

The American Cancer Society says that age group saw an overall increase in cancer cases between 1995 and 2020. The cancer society projects there will be about 2 million new cancer cases in the US this year and about 600,000 deaths.</p>

The latest items include a bean dip, chicken enchiladas, cilantro salad dressing, and taco kits sold at stores like Costco, Trader Joes and Albertson's. It follows the recall of more than 60 dairy products from California based "Rizo Lopez Foods" earlier this week.</p>

Right now, there is only one dentist that accepts Medicaid patients between Pensacola and Panama City. That's Dr. Charles Schildroth in Pensacola. The Arc Gateway serves more than 1,200 people who use Medicaid. A bill is moving through the Florida Legislature that could help solve the problem.

Baker Act patients are brought in involuntarily by law enforcement when they're having mental health issues. Law enforcement say the facility will make it easier for them to get these individuals the help they need. Local hospitals say it will also ease their workload.

He believes the “Ladarius Clardy Act” could be the answer. That’s a bill now pending in Tallahassee. Clardy was a standout football player at Pine Forest High School. He was shot more than 50 times and killed in his car on Fairfield Drive in 2021. Investigators later determined it was a case of mistaken identity and Clardy was not the intended target. The bill would make a drive-by a felony for everyone in a vehicle in which a gun is fired. The vehicle's owner could also be charged with a felony even if not in the vehicle.</p>

The center combines several technologies in one space to help officers identify crimes and quickly respond to them.
