

## WJGV 2nd QUARTER REPORT FOR 2014

The following program list represents broadcast by WJGV which have provided significant treatment toward Putnam county Issues.

\*\*\*Aired several County Commission Meetings of the quarter when not airing other local Public Affairs or Holiday Specials. The public was allowed from their homes the only broadcast viewing of the Putnam County Commission Meeting. Although the commission meeting does air on a county cable channel(99), it is not during a time convenient for public viewing in our opinion as does WJGV and whereas the cable channel only airs the meeting just 4 times, WJGV airs the meeting several times for viewers during a prime time period for informational needs. During this quarter the public affairs segments was aired on weeknights beginning at 9PM. Normal segments are 2 hours in length.

The main issue of controversial proportion was the sale of the landfill. Special Meeting on 5/6/14, aired on 5/6 and 5/7. Then regular meeting of 5/13, which was aired several times over the next week.

\*\*\*\*Aired all Palatka City Commission Meetings of the Quarter. Also aired during PA Segments weeknights at 9PM. Normal segments are 2 hours in length. Issues still before the Commission are those of the Controversial Overlay of St. Johns Ave. and the redevelopment projects taking place.

\*\*\*\*Interview with Supervisor of Elections, Charles Overturff, III, regarding upcoming local elections. Aired on 5/1, 5/2 and several other times as noted in programming log.

\*\*\*\*Aired Police Memorial Service on 5/8 and 5/9 at 9PM pre-empting other PAs.

\*\*\*\*Aired Memorial Day Special pre-empting Public Affairs Segment at 9PM on May 26<sup>th</sup>. The Program was from the past with Sister Dolly Harrell and Bro.
