(oyster reproduction lab); BATA = Business, Technology, Agriculture academy within school; Bill started the "Pluggers Scholarship"; Bill's hook: every day he showed his deep relationship with his students.

current; discussion of City Council and Mayor compensation; Santa Cruz has a new city manager, new police chief, and new fire chief; feels like a new chapter.

**Topic:** Interview with City of Santa Cruz Communications Director about new Sidewalk Vending Ordinance; SB946 took away local control of sidewalk vending; in response to problems that arose, City Council passed an ordinance that 1) bans sidewalk vending on Beach Street from the Wharf to 3rd Street from April to October, and 2) reverts the Pacific Garden Mall to a reservation system; City able to do this because SB946 allows regulation exception for health & safety; the sidewalk has to be wide enough for vendor plus pedestrians; Vendors will need a new permit requiring documentation; managed by City Parks Department; can get a permit same day! City has extended sidewalk dining, and is working on a permanent program.

measure may be a referendum on city governance, where a tax could be spent on anything; district election measure; non-partisan vs. partisan contests and run-offs.
