Wade; federal constitutional right to privacy now in question; California legislature now in 1 month summer recess, but recently achieved amazing things in the budget (\$25MM for Watsonville Hospital...still \$10MM short, but with 2 months to go, this should be manageable; \$20MM for Cal Poly facilities in Swanton (Forestry Program and beautiful house and facility); Sgt. Gutzweiler bill is in Assembly Committee, going through on consent (the perpetrator pled guilty to murder 2 days ago for life in prison without parole); lightning round committee run-down.

Topic:Interview and discussion of wildfires and controlled burns; prescribed fire in New Mexico flared up....4 months after being put out!; dilemma: fuel loads are too extreme, and we do not have an overarching policy; structural fires have different fire fighting teams than wildland fires, and most wildland fire fighting has no strategy to fight fires that threaten structures or communities; CalFIre grew out of federal forest fighting, and may know little of your community; Qs that you should ask your fire district / County Board of Supervisors / City Council: 1) Is there a back-up power plan for traffic signals and water systems? 2) Are you pre-filling water tanks just in case? 3) Are you pre-deploying teams to high risk areas? 4) Are you prepared for an event, by up-staffing on high risk days? and 5) Have you budgeted for the equivalent of 1/2 of the active resources to be loaded and held in reserve?

Topic:East Coast refugee, arrived Boulder Creek in 1979, and started playing music locally with her 1st husband, Allen Frank (who switched his name order as a performer); Back Alley Band...Blind Alley Band...Sharon Allen & the Firebirds - playing 4 nights a week, and 4 sets a night; started up with Dusty Boots 10 years ago; with the pandemic, Sharon pulls back on the reins more than anyone; started writing songs in the 1990s - can be wonderful, & frustrating.

Topic: Started in politics in 1998 - Scotts Valley School Board; appointed to replace Almquist on the County Board of Supervisors when Almquist was appointed judge; swam the English Channel in 2009 after 2 years of training, with the last 6 months the toughest; feet dry to feet dry...took over 8 hours...learned that to succeed, had to "break it down" into manageable pieces; Watsonville Hospital included in state budget, and signed; hospital in Robert Rivas' district; bill signed creates a "special district", which grants taxation powers; Watsonville Hospital requires taxation to fund operations; who draws the boundaries of the special district? LAFCO: the Local Agency Formation Commission, with appointed members who are all (except 1) elected officials; deep dive into legal aid in civil cases - the state bar has proposed 2 approaches but neither has a mechanism of accountability; Assembly back in session on Monday, with all bills required to be acted upon by midnight, August 31st.

Topic: Diablo Canyon nuclear power plate scheduled for shutdown in 2025; trailer bill with place-holder budget to study keeping it open signed in June; shutdown was a negotiated agreement, with a \$100MM bill passed to train staff and help the transition - \$80MM of which has been spent; starting a decision process with Laird laying out what needs to be in the proposal; 2 planned offshore wind projects off California, Morro Bay and Humboldt; discussion of the grid capacity and how wind would fit with a still working Diablo Canyon; Laird has 23 bills moving, and all bills have to be out by midnight August 31st = a combination of Whack-a-Mole and High Blood pressure!

Mother Hips is home base, and can count on it....solo incarnation more of a leader (as opposed to a democracy), with lead vocals more taxing, especially falsetto; making money in music these days is almost entirely playing live; discussion of falsetto lead singing and the need to rest his voice the day of a gig (performing tonight at Michael's-on-Main).

Topic: Born in Canada, but moved to Oahu when she was 10, and grew up dancing; friend introduced her to Santa Cruz...Redwoods...Ocean, and she fell in love; UCSC Environmental Studies student, worked at Museum of Art and History (MAH), and Monterey Bay Aquarium; started Te Hau Nui 25 years ago; discussion of difference between Hula (focus on hands and the relationship to the story) and Tahitian Dance (focus on hips); performed with Taj Mahal who wrote songs when he lived in Hawaii; Hula is different on different islands due to teachers; Santa Cruz and Hawaii both have people with strong bonds with the land, and people resonate; Hawiians call Santa Cruz the "9th Island".

Topic: 2 year anniversary of CZU fire; 900 structures destroyed, with 200 completed and 150 in permitting process; there are things the County controls, and things the State controls (like geology and environmental health) - and hold-ups at the State level are impacting rebuilding; a huge % cannot rebuild for what their insurance settlement paid due to supply chain issues and dramatic increase in the costs for re-building; County has no oversight of Cal Fire during fire season; Cal Fire declined to submit After Action Report to the County or the public (but they did review it internally)!; 8 years on City Council, almost 8 years on Board of Supervisors; most proud ot investment in kids and maternal health; homelessness review and Benchlands discussion; changing of the guard January 10th; Watsonville Hospital successfully funded! State #s for new housing units - some teeth, some arm waving.

Topic: last Wednesday was the Joint Fire Investigative Team meeting at "Michael's-on-Main" (the fire was on September 1st); tentative cause of the fire was a light timer that sparked; Michael and the landlord are waiting 90 days to determine if either party wants to break the 10 year lease; applying for a demolition permit; fortunate, as the cleaner for nearby Little Tampico came in early, saw the flames, and woke up Said, the owner, who is staying upstairs after his home was damaged in the CZU fire, called 911, then Michael; Michael and his wife Coleen took over from Michael Clarke in 2016, and changed the business model from fine dining to live music with high end pub food; Tommy Miller joined as booking manager in 2017; deep dive into cash flow (\$150k/month), profit (5-8%, 10% if lucky), and cost to buy a restaurant (\$200-600k without real estate); Michael and Coleen paid employees out-of-pocket - a GoFundMe campaign raised 2/3 of this; 37 on payroll when fire occurred, now 1; aiming to re-build and re-start, as live venues are important to musicians and the community.
