





Applicant: Sinclair Communications, Inc.

I am a Radio Engineer, an employee in the firm of Carl T. Jones Corporation with offices located in Springfield, Virginia. My education and experience are a matter of record with the Federal Communications Commission.

This office has been authorized by Sinclair Communications, Inc. ("Sinclair") to prepare this statement and the supporting exhibits and tables in support of an amendment to the above-referenced Application for Assignment of License in connection with Sinclair's group acquisition of Guy Gannett Communications ("Gannett"). Specifically, this material relates to Sinclair's acquisition of WGGB-TV, Springfield, Massachusetts.

Sinclair has an application currently pending at the FCC seeking authority to acquire WMHQ(TV), Albany-Schenectady, New York (FCC File No. BALCT-980821IB). Sinclair proposes herein to acquire WGGB-TV, Springfield, Massachusetts, as part of the group acquisition of Gannett. As demonstrated in Appendix C1 of the original filing, when the conventional FCC contour prediction methods are used, the predicted Grade A and Grade B service contours of the two television stations overlap. Further studies revealed that the small 16 square kilometer Grade A contour overlap area shown in the original filing is not predicted to occur when a supplemental prediction method is employed to predict the Grade A coverage contours in lieu of the FCC's F(50,50) propagation curves.

Because the terrain between the WMHQ(TV) transmitter site and the WGGB-TV transmitter site varies widely over the Berkshire Hills in western Massachusetts, an alternate prediction method, as contemplated in Section 73.684(4)(f) of the FCC rules, was employed to more accurately predict the locations of the WMHQ(TV) and the WGGB-TV Grade A service contours.¹

The Longley-Rice Irregular Terrain Model, version 1.2.2, was employed to predict the location of the television station's Grade A contours. Executing the Longley-Rice model allows the user the ability to input various path parameters in order to most closely approximate the unique circumstances for each RF path. In this instance, the input parameters were as follows:

In addition to the parameters specified above, terrain data, as obtained from the National Geophysical Data Center Topographic Database at 3 second intervals, for each profile radial was input into the model. A Continental temperature over land was considered for the radio climate, and the corresponding refractivity specified above was chosen. Because the Longley-Rice model is specifically intended for computer use, sample calculations are not included herein.

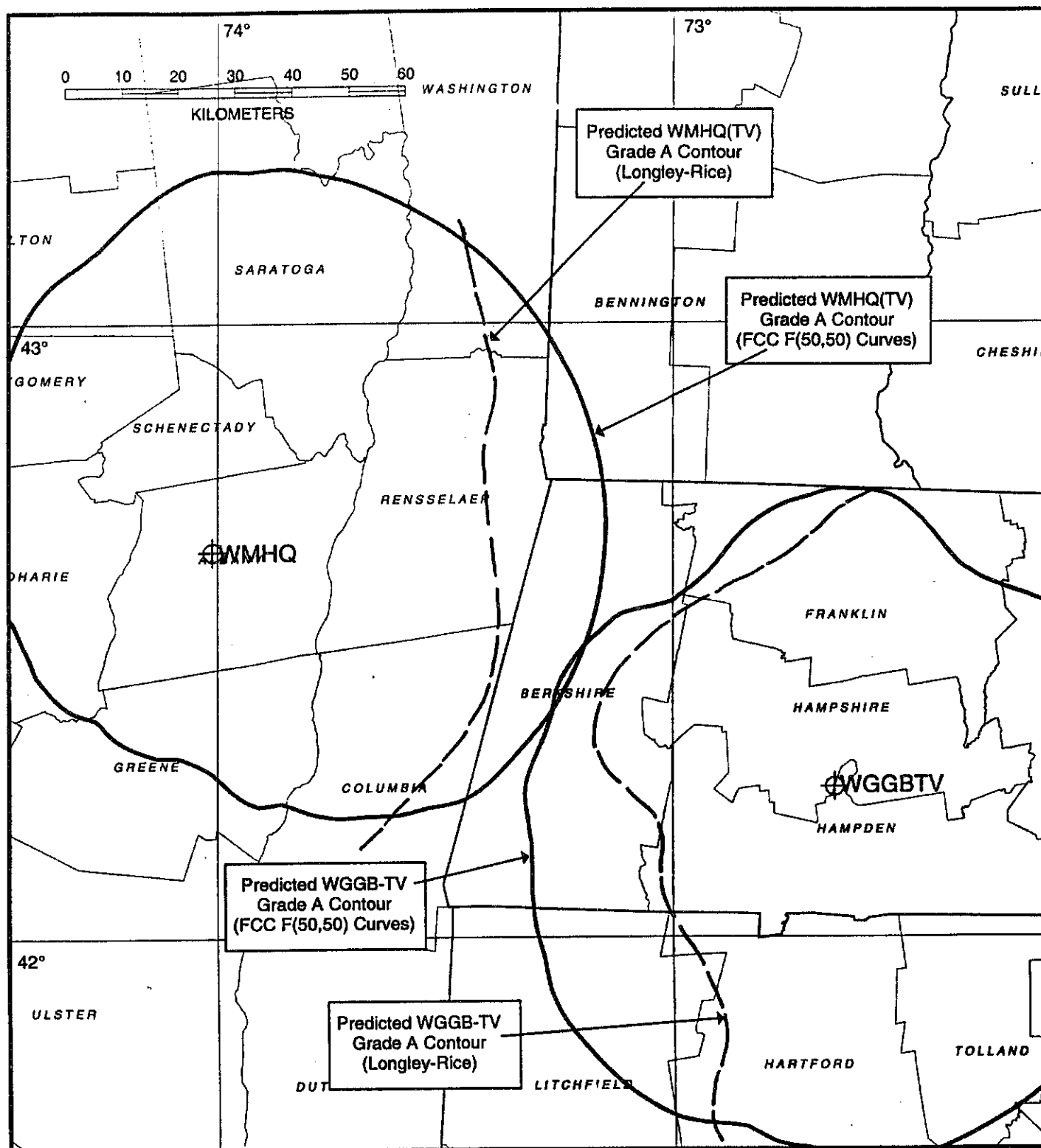
Exhibit 1 depicts the predicted WGGB-TV and WMHQ(TV) Grade A coverage contours using both the FCC's F(50,50) curves and the Longley-Rice propagation model. As illustrated in Exhibit 1, when the Longley-Rice alternate prediction method is employed, there is no predicted Grade A contour overlap between WGGB-TV and WMHQ(TV).

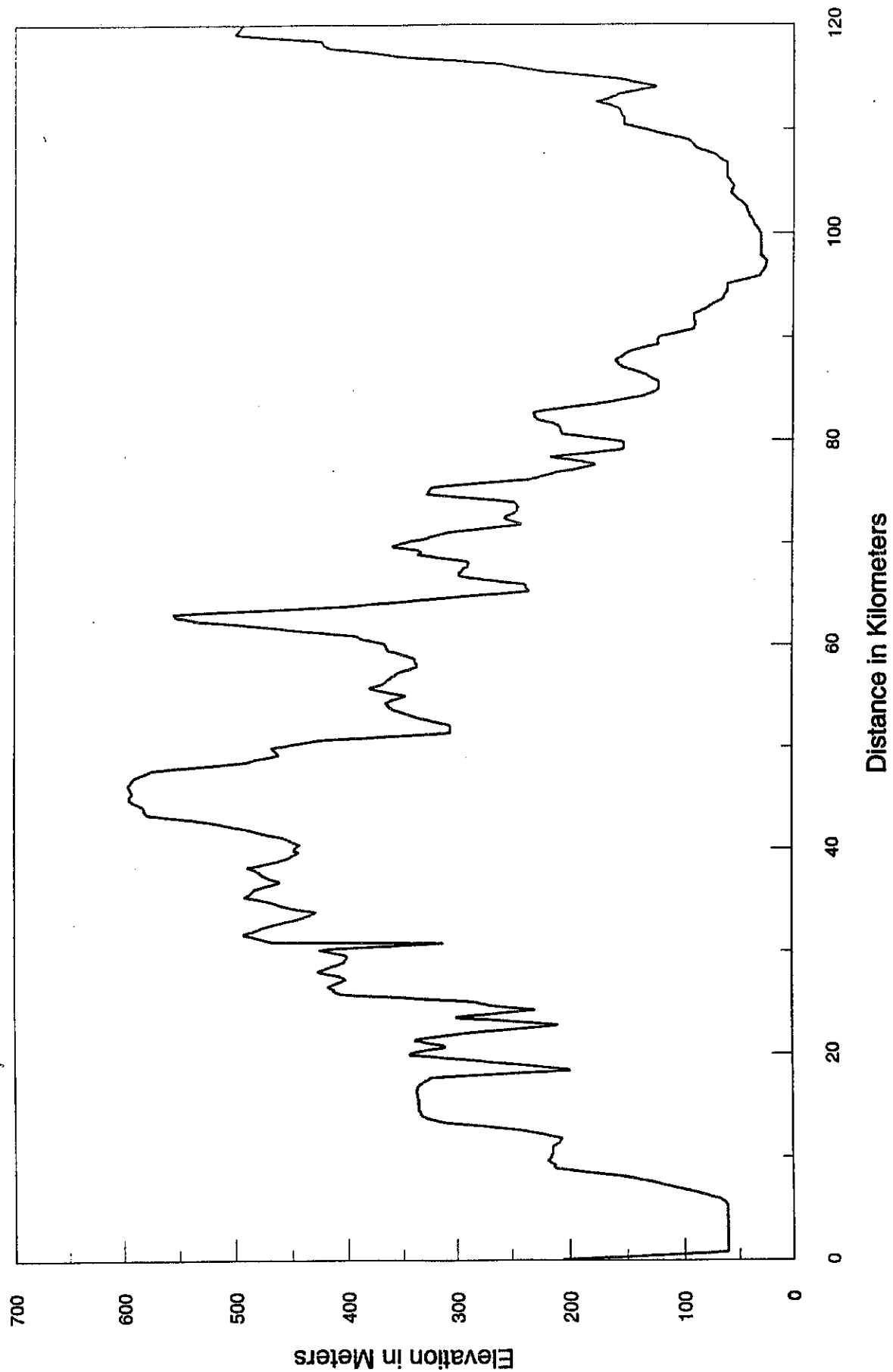
