SECTION –A-

Short & Long Form Programs

Program: Country Morning

Description: Each weekday morning from 6:30 to 7 AM Country Morning offers listeners a full half hour of farm news and features targeting topics of concern to producers in the Red River Valley. Country Morning is hosted by NAFB Farm Broadcaster Don Wick and originates from the studios of Red River Farm Network in Grand Forks, ND. Country morning airs on Simmons Multimedia Stations KNDK AM at Langdon and KXPO AM at Grafton, ND.

Air Time: Weekdays 6:30 to 7 AM

Program: Agriculture of America

Description: This is a daily 1 hour program that addresses national farm and agricultural issues. A typical hour will include agricultural news and market updates, interviews with farm experts and policy makers. A-O-A is heard on a number of stations and is heard on Simmons Multimedia Stations KNDK AM at Langdon, ND and KXPO AM at Grafton, ND. The program originates from the studios of The American Ag Network in Fargo, ND.

Air Time: Weekdays 11 AM to 12 Noon

Program: Agriculture Today

Description: This daily half hour program features late breaking news and features of interest to farmers in the upper Red River Valley. Typical offerings include agricultural news and information plus a segment devoted to farm weather as well as a calendar of farm related events of interest to local producers. Agriculture Today is another production of Grand Forks based Red River Farm Network and airs on Simmons Multimedia Stations KNDK AM at Langdon and KXPO AM at Grafton, ND.

Program Description: This daily hour long program is hosted by Erick Johnson who takes his microphone to gatherings of farmers and agriculture newsmakers across the region. The program airs on Simmons Multimedia Stations KNDK AM at Langdon and KXPO AM at Grafton, ND.

Program Description: This weekday afternoon program is hosted by Chip Flory and pits the spotlight on the day's commodity marketing trading and features interviews with top market analysts. Program Description: Throughout the year Simmons Multimedia Stations produce over 200 local high school and amateur sports play by play broadcasts. Such productions include high school hockey, basketball, football, volleyball, wrestling and track events. In addition to our terrestrial radio broadcasts live streaming of these games is provided via our station websites enabling distant family members, fans and school alumni the opportunity to hear the games.

Program Description: Each month representatives from the Cavalier County North Dakota Public Health District produce a series of programs targeting specific health care issues of importance to our listeners. Program Description: Week In Review is an hourly 2 to 3 minute recap of the local news stories and original content produced during the previous week by our Simmons Multimedia News Department. Late breaking local news is also incorporated into these newscasts when events warrant.

Newscast Overview

Section B: Newscast Overview

KNDK Radio produces 19 daily newscasts. Five minute 'morning drive' reports air following National News at 6, 7, 8 and 9am. Other reports occur following CBS National News at 10, 11, 2, 3 & 4 PM with condensed 'News Briefs' that occur during national talk programs from 5 PM to midnight. There is also an expanded thirty minute report during the noon hour each weekday. LOCAL news is also broadcast each weekend with 3 minute reports following National News every hour from 6am through 12 midnight.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature, based on its weight can air several times in the course of a day. In addition these stories are available to our audience on-demand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

Each day Simmons Stations air any number of free Public Service Announcements (PSA's) promoting the works of various charitable and non-profit groups and civic organizations.
