RE: North American Communications, Corp. ("North American"); WDSE"; Letter agreement regarding obligation to insert EAS messages

With this letter, North American requests that WDSE insert EAS alert messages on the channel on which the system carries WDSE. To memorialize the understanding that WDSE shall be required to insert EAS messages, North American and WDSE agree as follows:

- WDSE shall at all times be responsible for inserting EAS alert messages on the channel on which North American carries WDSE on the system located in *Bovey MN*.
- 2. North American agrees that it will not override the EAS alert messages provided by WDSE.
- If the parties operate under a retransmission consent agreement, this Letter Agreement modifies that agreement only to the extent stated herein. All other terms, conditions, representations, warranties and agreements in the applicable retransmission consent agreement shall continue in full force and effect as provided. Upon expiration of the retransmission consent agreement, this Letter Agreement shall become null and void.
- 4. This Letter Agreement shall be effective as of the date first mentioned above and shall continue pursuant to Section 3 or until either party gives 180 days prior written notice, whichever comes first.
- 5. This Letter Agreement may be executed in separate counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered (including without limitation via facsimile) will be deemed an original and all of which together will constitute the same agreement and will be binding on the signatory parties
