

KABC-TV LOS ANGELES ANNUAL EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT

I. GENERAL POLICY

This report covers the period from July 11, 2005 through July 10, 2006.

KABC-TV has a longstanding commitment to a policy of equal employment and advancement opportunities for all qualified individuals without regard to race, color, gender, marital status, religion, age, national origin, citizenship status, disability, sexual orientation, status as a Vietnam era or special disabled veteran, or any other protected characteristic as established by law.

This commitment to fair employment practices applies to every aspect of the employment process to ensure that equal consideration is extended to all employees and applicants in recruitment, selection procedures, employee development, performance evaluation, promotions, transfers, benefits and other aspects of employment.

It is our policy to promote the realization of equal employment opportunity through a positive, continuing program of specific recruitment, outreach, hiring, promotion and other practices designed to ensure the full realization of equal employment opportunity.

III. POSITIONS FILLED AND RECRUITMENT METHODS

KABC-TV has publicized job vacancies in the following ways except for positions filled through internal promotion and as indicated below:

1. Sending or emailing the KABC-TV job listing to the 84 organizations and schools detailed in *Attachment A*. We periodically broadcast on-air announcements publicizing the fact that qualified organizations may request to be added to our mailing list.
2. Placing help-wanted advertisements in the following minority publications: Chinese Daily News, Korea Times, La Opinion, LA Sentinel, Rafu Shimpo,

Wave.

3. Posting open positions on the station's website and job line.
4. For positions that came open prior to 5/1/06, posting open positions in the ABC Corporate Job Listing, which was sent to the 118 schools and organizations detailed in *Attachment B*.
5. For positions that came open after 5/1/06, posting open positions via DirectEmployers Association Network sites detailed in *Attachment C*.
6. Posting open positions in the Company online job listing.

IV. LONG TERM RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

KABC-TV is committed to performing on-going non-vacancy-specific recruitment efforts that bring attention to the variety of job and career opportunities at the Station. Outreach efforts are designed to provide easy access for candidates to apply for job opportunities, as well as provide information and training to develop a diverse pool of prospective candidates for the future.

A. Participation in Job Fairs – KABC-TV participated in 13 job fairs during the reporting period. B. Internship Program – KABC-TV's internship program offers year-round opportunities for currently enrolled college students interested in careers in television broadcasting. The internship program is designed to provide students with an on-site educational experience that complements their academic studies. Students earn college credit while participating and observing the daily work and operations of the KABC-TV. Every semester KABC-TV hosts an Intern Networking Reception. The Station's President and General Manager, V.P. News, V.P. Programming and V.P. Sales participate as guest speakers to provide information on the business of the television station, with a focus on career opportunities.

Recruitment outreach for interns is accomplished using a variety of methods. The KABC-TV Internship Program brochure and application are featured on the ABC7 website. Notices are sent and posted at local colleges, universities and minority organizations. In addition, internship

opportunities are posted through an internet service which targets the local colleges and universities.

Internship opportunities are promoted and applications are distributed at all job fairs, workshops and conferences, as listed on *Attachments D* and *F*.

Emma Bowen Foundation Intern – KABC-TV also participates with the Emma Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media. Working with the Emma Bowen Foundation, the Station makes a long term commitment to a high school or college student by providing paid employment through the duration of their college education. The student works part-time during the school year and through semester breaks. The salary the intern earns is matched dollar for dollar and deposited in an education account. The account is available to the student to assist with expenses for tuition, books and supplies. Our Emma Bowen Intern is a freshman at the University of California, Los Angeles.

C. Participation in Conventions, Workshops and Seminars – KABC-TV works closely with community based organizations to sponsor, assist with planning and implementation, and actively participate in conferences, conventions, workshops and seminars designed to provide information on career planning, job opportunities, resume writing and interview techniques. KABC-TV employee participation provides the opportunity to motivate and inspire interest specifically in careers in broadcast journalism, television production, communications and other related fields. Below is a sample of KABC-TV's participation in these events.

- Governor's Conference on Women and Families: Attended by over 10,000 women, this conference features a career and resource expo, as well as workshops on careers, self-improvement and issues affecting women. KABC-TV was a member of the planning committee, produced and aired several PSAs to promote and

advertise the event and provided speakers and talent to participate on the day of the event.

- **Adelante Mujer Latina-Career Resource Fair and Conference:** KABC-TV has been an active member of the planning committee for 11 years, provides financial sponsorship and provides speakers for this all-day conference and career fair targeting high school and college Latinas. In addition, participation included sharing information on careers and internships at the career and resource fair.
- **California Chicano News Media Association:** KABC-TV is a long time sponsor and participant of the CCNMA Journalism Opportunities Conference and Job Fair. Station employees participated as speakers at two workshops within the conference. The Resume and Interview Workshop provided guidance on job search strategies, resume writing and interview techniques. The Audition Tape Critique Workshop provided critiques and advice to aspiring reporters on creating a winning audition tape.
- **African American Youth Conference:** KABC-TV developed and implemented a Media Workshop specifically to introduce broadcast career opportunities to high school students. The workshop was presented exclusively by KABC-TV employees, with the objective of inspiring the next generation of broadcast employees.
- **Latino Young Men's Conference:** KABC-TV is a financial sponsor and participates on the planning committee for this conference attended by over 400 high school students. KABC-TV has designed a session focused on careers in broadcast journalism, providing station employees and talent as speakers.

D. Mentoring Programs – KABC-TV personnel participate in the ABC Corporate Mentoring Program. The program is designed to identify

talented minority and women employees at a senior management level who have demonstrated ability and commitment to the company. Mentees are paired with a senior executive for one year. The program provides exposure to business strategies across the media networks, networking opportunities with other executives from a cross-section of our businesses and the opportunity to enhance leadership skills.

- KABC-TV President and General Manager, Arnold J. Kleiner, participated as a mentor.
- KABC-TV had one female employee as a mentee in the program.

E. Sponsorship of Community Events to Inform the Public About Broadcast Employment Opportunities – KABC-TV sponsored and participated in events presented by community-based organizations whose missions focus specifically on opportunities in broadcasting. The events were designed to provide the general public with information on career opportunities in broadcasting and advice on how to prepare for and obtain a job.

- California Chicano News Media Association Journalism Opportunities Conference and Job Fair: KABC-TV participates as a financial sponsor, workshop presenter and job fair exhibitor.
- Imagen Foundation-Entertainment Industry Conference and Job Fair: KABC-TV sponsored this conference which features workshops on careers, interviewing techniques, resume writing, etc. In addition to participating as a job fair exhibitor, KABC-TV produced and aired a PSA to promote and advertise the job fair, as well as posted information on the ABC7 website with a link to the Imagen Foundation.

F. Participation in a Scholarship Program – KABC-TV is a founding member of the Advisory Board for Hispanic Americans for Fairness in

Media. KABC-TV is a major supporter and partner with HAFIM in the development, implementation and on-going oversight of the HAFIM Scholarship and Mentor Program. KABC-TV is the exclusive broadcast partner with HAFIM in the planning, selection and presentation of the scholarship awards presented to students pursuing a college education in the fields of television, radio and film. In addition, KABC-TV conceived, designed and implemented the HAFIM Mentor Program that matches the scholarship recipients with working media professionals in their field of interest.

- G. Other Activities – KABC-TV hosts bi-monthly meetings in communities throughout our broadcast area called “ABC7 Listens” Community Meetings. The objective is to introduce the television station to local residents and community leaders and to obtain feedback on how the Station is serving the community. A significant part of the meetings is presenting information to the community on job opportunities and introduce the Station’s internship program. Brochures, job postings and applications are distributed at every meeting and residents are encouraged to apply for open positions.

KABC-TV has a long term goal of motivating and inspiring the next generation of broadcast professionals. To support that goal, the Station hosts high school and college students at the television station to expose them to the variety of career options available in broadcasting. Student groups are provided with a tour of the behind the scenes operations, a live news broadcast and a guest speaker to discuss the career opportunities. The students received advice and guidance on the educational requirements to qualify for future opportunities.
