Re: Election of Retransmission Consent Status (Pinal County, AZ) KMSB, Tucson, AZ

To Whom it May Concern:

Sander Operating Co. V LLC d/b/a KMSB Television ("Licensee"), licensee of KMSB, Tucson, AZ, (Facility ID 44052) (the "Station"), located in the Tucson (Sierra Vista) DMA, hereby notifies you in accordance with Section 76.66(d)(6) of the FCC's rules¹ that Licensee elects retransmission consent status for the Station with respect to Pinal County, AZ, which was added to the Station's local satellite market by the FCC Media Bureau's order of April 8, 2024.² For the avoidance of doubt, Licensee's election of retransmission consent status for the Station with respect to all other portions of the Station's local satellite market remains in effect without change.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC's rules, the Station's broadcast signal may not be carried on your satellite or other multichannel video programming distribution systems except with Licensee's express written consent pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement. Pursuant to Section 76.66(d)(1)(iii) of the FCC's rules, this election of retransmission consent applies through December 31, 2026, and subsequently until and unless Licensee notifies you of a change in such election.
