Shootings by LA police officers spiked by more than 50% in 2015 The LAPD report also showed that black people were five times more likely to be shot by police than white people and 2.6 times more likely than Latinos. Forty-eight people were shot by officers in 2015, up from 30 in 2014, according to the LAPD report.
