04/11/2022 at 09:00 am to 10:00 am...2 hours...Catholic Connection. The host is Teresa Tomeo. Teresa is talking to Pete Burak, who is the director of id, the young adult outreach of Renewal Ministries. On April 22 and 23 the Renewal Ministries is having a Gathering in Ypsilanti featuring Dr. Ralph Martin, Peter Herbeck and more. Friends, relatives and neighbors are coming together to worship the Lord and see what the Holy Spirit has to say to them.

04/28/2022 at 09:00 am...to 10:00 am...2 hours...Catholic Connection. The host is Teresa Tomeo. Teresa talked with Dr. Peter Kleponis, who is helping people who struggle with pornography addiction. Since the covid virus has been here, he has seen an increase of pornography use, addiction and sexual addiction. People have been dealing with isolation, combined with loneliness, boredom and they have access to the internet and so they are getting into pornography. 04/13/2022 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders and his guest is Tom Price. Dr. Anders talked about why did God create Judas? Anybody who dies without the grace of God should not have been borne. Judas played a part in the divine providence of Christ. He was the agent that betrayed Jesus and thus the prophecy of the Messiah that he would be betrayed was fulfilled. Dr. Anders tells us that Jesus used Judas's free will and his determination to sin to further His own divine purposes. That's the mystery of divine providence and although God does not will any evil directly, He is capable of the foreknowledge of our evil and can use this knowledge for a good purpose.

04/20/2022 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders took a call from a recent convert to the Catholic Church. He told Dr. Anders that one of the things that brought him into the Catholic Church was a substitution transaction theory of Jesus's atonement on the cross, this idea that God was rendering a punishment on His son instead of me. His sponsor said no God doesn't punish. Dr. Anders said punishment comes through being afraid. If you are in fear, you are not perfected in God's love. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says purgatory is the final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned.

05/07/2022 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. A caller called in to ask if scapulars and miraculous medals could be looked at as superstitious? Dr. Anders said they could be and might not be depending on how they are used. He said the church teaches that any devotional practice, any lecturical form and spiritual practices of any kind, if it deflects from the right worship of God,

which is to love God above all things and our neighbor as ourselves, then they should not be used. So he says when you use sacramental's you should use them in such a way that it encourages you in love of God and neighbor and away from a magical conception of a spiritual life.

05/14/2022 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders received a call from a man who was married to a Protestant Evangelical. They just had their baby baptized in the Catholic Church. Afterwards she said that her father, who was a pastor at his church, wanted to have the baby go through a dedication ceremony at his church. The caller explained to her that the dedication ceremony is a denigration of the Catholic Church's meaning of baptism and a rejection of the doctrine of original sin. Dr. Anders said his opinion would be to explain to his father in law that baptism is a dedication of the child to God.

06/15/2022 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders was asked a question. Did the third person of the Trinity always exist? The Holy Spirit is said to be the love between the Father and the Son. They loved each other so much that their love turned in to the third person of the Holy Trinity and therefore the Holy Spirit didn't always exist.

Dr. Anders answers by saying there are a few problems in the understanding. The Trinity of the persons is eternal. This is the Catholic dogma. The Son eternally proceeds from the Father by way of generation. This is a distinction of the essence of the God head. The father and son love each other and their love doesn't cause the spirit to be or to come into existence. There is a relation of love between the father and son that is an eternal relationship which is understood to be the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit didn't come into being anymore then the Son came into being they were begotten.

A called told Dr. Anders that he often hears from Catholic's that Mary said yes to being chosen to be the mother of Christ. How could she say yes to a question that she was never asked? 04/12/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in-show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about people saying that they like to avoid people who disturb their peace. Dr. Ray asks these questions: Would it be good to look at yourself and say why are they disturbing your peace? Are you giving them the power over you by interpreting

what they say and do? What is it about me that is allowing them to disturb my peace? Do we automatically assume that just because somebody is a certain way that we don't like them? Are they difficult, hurtful, opinionated, snotty? Dr. Ray says we have a lot of power on who we allow to disturb our peace. People say you can just avoid them. This could be difficult if they are people in your close emotional circle.

04/21/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about being consistent. He says when you hear the word consistent it means you have to be 100%. Most parents live in a reality of being 5 to 20% consistent about disciplining their children. Some people think this is too low of a percentage. Dr. Ray says for most of us that percentage gets the job done. Parents think they are being consistent when they give their child or children a warning. But Dr. Ray says this is just a warning not disciplining them.

05/11/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is In...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on counseling.

Dr. Ray asked a question. Do you think you are spoiled? His opinion is that people would say that using the word spoiled is extreme. Dr. Ray thinks that we live spoiled. He says look at the way we live. Think about this, when was the last time you didn't have a hot shower, or clean running water, or all the food you could eat, air conditioning in your house and car, a TV with options for entertainment. People live a certain way, they get use to it and they don't want to change it. So when there is a hiccup in their life style, they fuse about it. They don't want to make changes. They have become complacent and dissatisfied with change.

05/18/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked to an anonymous called that he named sister. Sister's sister had passed away and was cremated because of lack of funds to bury her. Her niece wants her sister's ashes. She is afraid to give them to her because she is not a Christian person and she wants to honor her sister's wishes for a proper burial. The relationship between her sister and her niece was rocky. Dr. Ray says to honor your sister's last wishes and give her a proper burial.

06/15/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray started the hour program talking about how to handle a teenager who doesn't want to follow the rules of the house. He says one of the things a father will do is hold court. Holding court is devastating. It is not good for the relationships of the family members. A child is complaining about a disagreement with his or her mother. The father talks to his wife about the problem and then to his daughter seeking her side of

the story. He is attempting to find some compromise but what happens is the wife is being questioned because the daughter said it didn't go that way. It looks like he is sorting through the problem so he can affix blame to one party. He doesn't do this deliberately, but it comes across that way. Dr. Ray says the antidote for holding court is to take the bullet for his wife. This means when she gets into a problem with a child she should tell the child you need to talk to your father. This is his ruling, his idea. When the child seeks out the father, he should say it is my ruling, so what's your problem with it. This way the father is not finding fault on either side.

06/27/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about when he worked at a mental health center in Columbian County, OH. He did a lot of evaluations for the juvenile court. He talked about being in court to testify and they would want him to make a prediction of how violent and dangerous a juvenile could be. How likely would this child be to do something that is harmful? Now the assumption is that because you are a trained psychologist you would be more aware and sensitive to people's behavior and could predict their behavior. So Dr. Ray went to the library to study on how accurate the predictions of experts are regarding violence. He said you can flip a coin. That is the most accurate level of predicting violence.

Jody asks the question, how does America recognize the National Day of Prayer, when it has rejected the idea of an organized religion? Also, how does the decline in confessional Christianity correlate with the rise in identity politics?

05/12/2022 at 4:00 pm...*Al Kresta in the Afternoon*...90 minutes...Marcus Peter sits in for Al Kresta. Marcus talked to Kevin Symonds about the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima. On May 13, 1917, Our Blessed Mother Mary appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. Marcus asked Kevin why is Fatima considered the gold standard for Marian apparitions? Kevin explained that there are a lot of things that went right with the apparitions. If you have a list of check boxes to say if something is from God or not, Fatima checks off many of them and there are not too many oddities, or questionables or suspicions that happened during the course of the events themselves or in later examinations. That's why it's considered the gold star of Marian Apparitions.

Young people don't want to be cynical about life, so they don't want to hear older people's negative points of view. Al agreed with this. Al says consumers like crime stories, but not necessarily crime with violence. Al went through a list of 100 pod casts, half dealt with true crime. He says with all the world has to offer in the arts, sciences, short stories, religion, novels, travel people are interested in true crime.

6/22/2022 at 4:00 pm...*Al Kresta in the Afternoon*...90 minutes... Al Kresta Comments:

Al talked with John Pinheiro, who is a professor of history and the founding director of Catholic Studies at Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, MI.

They are talking about the question of whether Roman Catholicism is compatible with the American project in liberal democracy remains contentious and some contemporary Catholic intellectuals would say it is not. Dr. John Pinheiro joins us with an analysis of the Founding period in light of the principles of Catholic social teaching.

They talked about how religion is treated by American Historians. Al says they are real people with lots of differences. When Al was in college in the 1970's religion was almost entirely ignored by people who talked about the history of the United States. It was there with the Puritans, but religion was almost marginal in American History. As Al got

older and read more, he thought that religion has been a real dynamic force in American History. John says religion is a big profession.
