When we get to know them we may want to pray to them for their intercession. Also you can consecrate yourself to a saint, emulating their life so you can become more like them.

A caller called in to say that she was at a family get together and she made a comment that the people there did not believe in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. These people were of the protestant faith. They got upset with her and said

that they do believe. Dr. Anders then talked about Martin Luther who rejected the mass, but believed in the real presence of Christ. Ulrich Zwingli, from Switzerland in 1520 believed that Christ was not a part of the Eucharist. He said He is only a symbol. John Calvin brought these two protestant believers together by saying Christ is in the Eucharist sort of. These three positions still remain in protestant faith today.

In other words that he doesn't make a mistake in his judgement.

Dr. Ray talked about one reason parents come to Dr. Rays office is because they think their child is depressed or unhappy. The child may have been diagnosed by another doctor and they are seeking Dr. Ray for another opinion to deal with their problems. Older children are dissatisfied with their parents because they are not keeping up with technology or with events that are happening in this world. This brings friction into the household. Dr. Ray says don't interact with the child on their level. Be the parent. If the child gets mouthy take their phone away for the day. Be consistent with them. Take charge, they will respect you for it.

01/26/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about parents coming to him with children problems. One mom complained that her son was lazy, he watched too much T V and he ate too much. Dr. Ray asked if the mother wanted her son to be like her and she said no. She said I watch too much TV, I am lazy with chores and I eat too much. She felt because she didn't meet up to her own expectations she couldn't ask him to. Dr. Ray explained to her that even though she couldn't meet these expectations that she would want her son to try his best anyway. She had to teach him to be accountable for himself.

02/09/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is In...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on counseling.

Dr. Ray talked about parents who ask him about how long is it going to take for their child to understand and respond to them correctly when they are being disciplined. He goes on to say that some parents put their child in the corner of a room when they torment a brother or sister. This doesn't seem to help, because the child keeps misbehaving. A parent had a child write down 25 nice things about the house he was complaining about. Dr. Ray said that parents everywhere want a quicker way of changing their children. They first need to look at themselves and see how long it takes them to make changes in themselves. Parents talk, threaten their children, but they don't do anything about it. And yet they expect their children to change just because they asked them to.

02/22/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about his years in school studying to be a psychologist and taking a psychology course. In this course they talked about memory. It was explained to them that people can only remember seven digits at a time. That is why phone numbers are seven digits. Because of the number of people the phone companies had to add on an area code. Now people have to break a phone number into three digits at a time. This helps us to remember the numbers.

03/10/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray started the program by saying that many years ago when he was with another network, he got a call from a mom who was feeling guilty as she had found her daughter's papers with feelings written on them. Some would call this a diary. She had her feeling, her perceptions of her life and friends, her desire's, her wants and her angers, and her upsets etc. Her mother opened and read the papers and was socked with what she read. She didn't like the language or what her daughter was doing. She had no idea that this stuff was going on in her daughter's life. The mother talked to Dr. Ray and he was thinking that the mother would ask what she could do about this

information. He said instead mom told him that her daughter said she had no right to read her private papers. Dr. Ray told the mother that she had the right to protect her child from her bad judgement's. He feels a parent has the right to check into their children's things. If you see changes in your child ask questions, check their thing's, see what is going on in their world. They have no right to privacy. You are a parent and need to know what they are doing.

03/23/2022 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about the culture of this world and how it affects our children. Our children start wanting to watch vile video games, watch TV unsupervised and they want a cell phone that can go anywhere in this ugly world. Dr. Ray says that parents will tell him that this is not going to hurt their child. He says do you judge something by thinking it's not going to hurt you or do you ask yourself is it going to help you? We need to raise our children in a virtuous life so they can made decisions that will make their lives better. We should not allow our children to participate in activities that are not good for a child's well being and soul. Saying it is not going to hurt them. What kind of reason is that?

01/04/2022 at 11:00 am...Women of Grace...30 minutes...Encore from 1/5/21. Host is Johnnette Williams. Johnnette talks about Conversion and Surrender. In the mist of all this suffering, she baptized babies under this communist regime.

Al was looking up purgatory in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. He shared a paragraph on purgatory with us. Al talked with Dr. Matthew Bunson, an executive at the Washington Bureau, about the announcement of Pope Francis doing a public consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on March 25, 2022. And also his papal envoy will do the same in Fatima. Dr. Matt was surprised at this announcement. Since 3/2/2022, the Ukrainian bishops have been writing to the Pope to ask for this consecration because of the sufferings of the people. They asked his Holiness for a public act of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary for Russia and Ukraine as was requested by the Virgin Mary.
