#### **Advertising Grant** 10/1-10/30

The Eagle supported the Cox Media Group Advertising Grant. During the month of October, Cox Media Group supported local businesses by having them sign up for our Advertising Grant, sponsored by Beyer Boys Air Conditioning, Heating and Plumbing. Local small businesses were asked to apply for a \$10,000 Advertising Grant, by writing an essay detailing the impact the Covid-19 pandemic had on the their business, the impact of their business on the community, as well as the employee loyalty and business culture. Ten winners were selected and were each given a \$10,000 advertising grant to promote their local business.

#### **Treats for Troops** 10/28-11/2


