Section I Issues.

The News /Talk Station WBSM has identified the following issues as significant facing our community this quarter:

Food Insecurity/Hunger: The pandemic has increased a need that was already too high in the area according to United Way of Greater New Bedford. Food insecurity has multiplied for those who have experienced the loss of a job or a reduction in work hours.

Housing: According to United Interfaith Action, nearly half of New Bedford households are "cost burdened," spending more than 30 percent of their income on housing costs.

Art and Culture: The SouthCoast seeks enrichment. Local groups are bringing exhibits and other activities to residents to experience together.

Politics: Local and national governments have seen many changes and impactful events.

Education: Changes have been made to the local college campus, closing a heritage art school building in Downtown New Bedford. School libraries are also vanishing across the region.

Transportation: Local officials are working to make affordable and free public transportation a priority for the region.

Public Health: The opioid crisis and the suicide epidemic continue to affect the Greater New Bedford area.
