The former councilmembers have the choice of taking the plea deal or pursuing a new trial. Spaccia's attorney says that if he is successful in questioning Rizzo and getting him to admit to masterminding the fraud, Spaccia could get as little as 3 years instead of 12. The city of Bell wants to know where the missing money went.</p>
