

# WAKR, WONE-FM, WQMX, WNWV 2024, 1st Quarter Community Issues/Programs

During 2023, a survey was conducted by the Center for Marketing and Opinion Research to assess the community needs facing Northeast Ohio and Summit County. According to the most recent information we have, the problems noted during the period fell into the following categories (presented in order of importance):

INFLATION/FUEL PRICES: During 2023, Inflation and Fuel Costs rose substantially. Groceries and commuting costs have also grown, creating hardships for many and housing costs are a major concern. While Northeast Ohio enjoys a comparatively low cost of living, recent increases are just as painful here as they are in traditionally more expensive regions.

### **Regularly Scheduled Programs**

In addition to the programs listed, stations also provided the following regularly scheduled news and community service programming:

**WAKR News** – 3:00 length local newscasts 5am-9am, M-F at the top and bottom of each of each hour 5:30am - 8:30am, and top of the hour following CBS News 9a-1p.

**CBS News** – airs on 1590 WAKR Newscasts are 6:00 in length until 9am M-F, with the exception of the World News Roundup at 8:00 am, M-F (10 minutes) and 1-min hourly updates throughout the day.

**WAKR Ray Horner Sho**w – 6:00 am - 9:00 am, Monday-Friday. News, sports, weather, traffic, business and topical interviews of local, national and community interest.

**America in the Morning** - airs on 1590 WAKR 5:00 am – 6:00am, M-F with topical news, sports, business and information. 54:00 length. Network program.

**WONE News** – 1:30 length hourly local newscasts 6a-8a weekdays. These newscasts are conversational in nature and air at 6:40am, 7:40am and 8:40am.

**WQMX News** – 2:30 length local newscasts 5:30a-8:30a at the top and bottom of each hour weekdays.

**Weather Updates** - all stations present weather updates at least every hour during live programming and break into programming when severe weather events warrant.

**Traffic Updates** - All stations: regular traffic and highway construction updates at least three times each hour on WNWV, WAKR, WONE & WQMX during weekday mornings. Updates are provided weekday afternoons as needed. On WNWV, such traffic reports focus on Cleveland & Cuyahoga County since it's City of License resides within the Cleveland market.

**Spectrum** – produced by the RCRG Newsroom presenting in-depth treatment of local, regional and national issues. Some programs also include presentations of the City Club of Cleveland highlighting a wide range of programming. Airs on WAKR, WONE-FM & WNWV. More detail on this program is provided elsewhere in this report.

**Forum 360** – produced by the Shaw Jewish Community Center of Akron in association with the Rubber City Radio Group, a 30-minute program airs each Monday morning at 12:30 a.m. on WAKR and Sunday at 6:30 a.m. on WONE at 5:30 p.m. on WAKR depending on sports schedules.

**Center Talks** – produced by the Akron Urban League and 1590 WAKR with information on agencies and programs of benefit to the Akron urban community. This program runs 30:00.

**CBS Weekend Roundup** - a 48:00 minute review of the week's biggest news stories. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

**CBS Face the Nation** - a 58:00 program with news and debate originating in Washington, D.C. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

#### **RCRG Community Outreach**

As part of our continued community outreach, RCRG works in partnership with various community groups to both raise funds and help operations of non-profit charitable groups and profile worthwhile community events. Among the initiatives for this quarter:

#### **WAKR Community Service:**

- WAKR Night at the Cavs. On Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>, WAKR Staff took a busload of listeners to Downtown Cleveland for an evening at the Cleveland Cavaliers. This was designed as a fundraising event for the Salvation Army of Summit County. \$1,500 was raised for the Army.
- WAKR Junior Achievement Day. On March 7<sup>th</sup>, and in partnership with the Pro Football Hall of Fame, in Canton, and Junior Achievement, WAKR sponsored this community outreach with area high school students. WAKR created a "Mock Radio Station" for the students to experience in order to learn about careers in Radio. Specifically, they learned about the daily experiences of radio announcers, and news reporters.

## **WQMX Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:**

- American Heart Association. During the period, and specifically in January, WQMX ran on-air support for the Heart Association's Heart Month (in February.)
- WQMX Charity Concert. On Jan. 25<sup>th</sup>, WQMX hosted a sold-out featuring country artist Scotty McCreery. The show was staged at The Dusty Armadillo and raised over \$11,000 for WQMX Bosom Buddies. A partnership with Cleveland Clinic/Akron General Hospital that provides mammograms free of charge to those who cannot afford them. The event was supported with on-air marketing and social media.
- Akron Rotary Foundation. The Akron Rotary operates a summer camp for children with special needs. On Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>, the Rotary hosted a wintertime gold tournament, The Rotary Chili Open. Golfers play golf in the snow, then come inside and enjoy chili, raising money for the summer camp. WQMX supported the event with on-air promotion and morning show interviews in advance of the event.
- **Habitat for Humanity.** On March 12<sup>th</sup>, Akron's Habitat for Humanity hosted "Build in Style". A women's fundraising event where gently used purses, and jewelry were sold to raise money for Habitat's 2024 Women Build Project. The event was emceed by WQMX Personality, Cherise and was supported by on-air promotion and social media.
- **NEOPAT.** On Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, WQMX hosted Red, White & Bowl, at Akron's Station 300 Bowling Center. The fundraising event was staged in support of the Northeast Ohio Foundation for Patriotism which supports programs that provide services for veterans and military families in need of help. The day included an acoustic performance by country artist Ryan Larkins and raised nearly \$4,000 for the program. The event was supported with on-air marketing and social media.
- **WQMX Charity Concert.** On March 28<sup>th</sup>, WQMX hosted a charity concert w/Chayce Beckham & Zach Top. The show was staged at The Dusty Armadillo and raised over \$16,000 for NEOPAT. The event was supported with on-air marketing and social media.
- **WQMX Pet Rescue**: A continuing on air feature which presents adoptable pets every Thursday morning at 8:40.

#### **WONE Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:**

- **Summit County Valor Home.** During the Period, WONE-FM staged several events in support of the Valor Home, which provides housing for needy veterans. Most of the events raise funds for the Home and others are intended to raise awareness. All are supported by on-air discussion and social media. Here are some of the events.
  - WONE Online Store. This is WONE's Branded Merch store. A portion of all sales are designated for the Valor Home.
  - Cleveland Browns Watch Party. October 1<sup>st</sup>, The station sponsored this watch party at The Galaxy, in Wadsworth as a fundraiser.
  - WONE Online Fundraising Campaign. This ran during the month of November along with on-air discussion of the activities of the Valor Home.
  - Operation Heroes. During the week of October 27<sup>th</sup>, WONE provided on-air support for this event staged at Lowes Home Center, in Green to assist local veterans.
- Walk to End Alzheimer's. WONE-FM provided on-air support to this event staged by the Alzheimer's Association. WONE's Matt Spatz participated in the Walk.
- Coats & Cans for Kids. On November 11<sup>th</sup>, WONE provided on-air support and participated in this seasonal charity event, which was staged in Fairlawn, at the offices of a local Law Firm. WONE's Matt Spatz and Amanda Casey appeared at the event.
- **Fire Safety.** During the week of October 9<sup>th</sup>, WONE aired support for a fire safety education program being staged at Lowes Home Center, in Green, Ohio.
- Achieving Dreams, Back to School. On November 11<sup>th</sup>, in partnership with Akron's
  Project GRAD, the WONE morning show hosted agency supporters in the WONE Studios
  for "Spend The Morning with Spatz & Amanda." This was a fundraising auction item in an
  event held earlier in the year by Project GRAD, which raises scholarships for Akron Publiuc
  School students to go to college.

- **Pet of The Week:** The WONE Morning team interviews representatives from the Summit County Humane Society every Wednesday. Homeless pets are featured, usually one cat and one dog, as a way to get these animals adopted.
