from 6-7pm. These calls are private. We initiated this program so that those who are too poor or too frightened to seek medical care in-person might do so from the comfort of their own homes. Many times, "our" doctors have spent time on the phone convincing callers to get to a doctor who can help them. The program airs from September through the last Monday in May prior to Memorial Day.

Focus on Health Mondays, 5 PM

Doctor Robin Miller joins our team on the news set and answers topical questions for the day. She also answers appropriate email questions that she receives.
