WAXQ provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- 9/11 1st responders; government; community; health: .attormey michel barasch and his outreach person, former fdny deputy chief richard alles, discussed their latest lobbying in DC to make the victim compensation fund permanent to help ailing 9/11 1s responders.
- 9/11 illnesses; terrorism; community: Michael Frazier is the exec director or the 9/11 musuem and memorial which is about to open the glade, an outdoor area totally dedicated to all the 9/11 first responders and others who died of post 9/11 illnesses.
- 9/11; 9/11 illnesses; afterlife; community: Aspenleiter & McKee are 2 sisters of the late FDNY'ers Ray Pfeifer, who while he was dying, travel lobbed to DC to lobby congress to provide aid to ailing 9/11 first responders.
- 9/11; 9/11 illnesses; cancer; healing; communiy: diane holland lost her NYPD husband, Richard, to 9/11 cancer and organized HOPs, Hslping Our POst 9/11 survivors, making quilts for families of ailing NYPD 9/11 responders,
- 9/11; 9/11 illnesses; first responders; caregivers: vet and FDNY widow kimberley mcdonaugh talked about losing her lt husband, eddie, to 9/11 cancer and the difficulties caring for him and their young sosn.
- ailing 9/11 first responders; community: Rob Tilearcio & bridget gormley both lost their fathers to 9/11 cancers. as a result, they ended up working for 9/11 community attorney michael barasch, who reps more post 9/11 victims than any law firm on earth.
- cults; women's rights;: Mary Harron directed "Charlie says", which centers on the women imprisoned after carry out the Charles Manson-directed murders 50 years ago. Guinevere Turner grew up in a cult, which her mom joined at 19 when she became pregnant with her.
- education; civil rights; culture; ecnomy; youth: tom Jones directed and produced a doc about Asbury Park, NJ's musical and racial roots and how the riots 50 years ago economically devastated the town and how music helped bring it back.

- ems; first responders; LBGTQ rights; women's right: Lillian Bonsignore was just appointed NYC EMS chief- the first woman to hold that job. She is now the highest ranking announced LGBTQ'er in the NYC Fire Dept.
- environment; community: the directors & producer of "dismey nature: penguins" joined the head of the global penguin society to discuss disney nature's latest earth day offering educating about a variety of penguins.
- gay rights: Greta Schiller directed the 1984 doc "Before Stonewell: the making of the gay & lesiban community", which has just been rereleased. It detailed what life was like in the LGBTQ community before there WAS a gay riot iin NYC 50 years ago, when police raided the gay bar, the stonewall inn
- gay rights; community: chris frederick is the executive director or heritage of pride, which is organing the pride events in nyc the last weekend of the month, coinciding with the 50 year anniversary of the stonewall riots, the start of the gay pride movement in the us.
- healing divisiveness; education; culture; career: .Jonathan Levine directed "Long Shot", a political satire starring Charlize Theron and Seth Rogan with her as a presidentia candidate and he the man who fell for her when she babysat him years before. it's a comment on our politically divided times.
- health; parenting: Dr, Josh Dines is the orthopedic doctor for the NY Rangers and NY Mets. He discussed how to avoid sports injuries in kids, how to train kids and when to know knee surgery is required.
- lyme disease; music: Jesse Colin Young, best known for "Get Together" had most of his life & career stolen from undiagnosed Lyme disease.
- minority rights; equal justice; the death penalty: .trey ellis is a columbia university professor and producer of the HBO doc "True Justice: Bryan Stevenson's fight for equality". Attorney stevenson founded the Equal Justice Initiative to help poor, incarcerated and condemned inmates.
- small business; economy; technology; aging: ricky kelly founded carmine street guitars, which h features hand-made guitars made form wood retrieved from old NYC buildings. his elderly mom still works for him daily in his greenwich village store.
- terorism; rape as a weapon of war: Eca husson directed "girls of the sun", based on true stories of Iraqi women kidnapped by isis, held as sex slaves, who escaped and then formed a militia group to hunt down and kill isis members.
- transgender kds; LGBTQ; law: The mom of a young transgender girl discussed the latest legal threats to transgender kids, putting them at risk of bullying. It's all about the bathroom laws.

- women's rights; sports: Tracy Edwards headed the first all-female crew ever to win a round-the world yachting race 30 years ago.
