WAXQ provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- .hunger/community: noreen is the ececutive director if why hunger, which annually raises monmey for the hungry and homeless in the tri state area. ken dashow guest-hosted this segment.
- .urban appeciation; community; careers; alt lives: oscar nominated actor and longtime Q104.3 fan jeese eisenberg produced "the world before your feet" detailing the 6 year project of young man who has made it his mission to walk every street, beach and bridge in NYC.
- 1st responders; health; 9/11 illness: lisa orloff founded the world cares foundation after she volunteered in the months after 9/11 and realized first responders and volunteers need to be trained to prevent another 9/11 illness catastrophe.
- 9/11 illness; community; spirituality: father chris succeeded fdny chaplain myke judge, who was killed at thje wtc 9/11. as a result of his work at ground zero, father chris has skin cancer as we continue to try to alert up to 400-thousand who may be ailing from 9/11 toxinspeople entitled to free lifetime medical care and compensation from the victim compensation fund.
- 9/11 illnesses; 1st repsonders: .maggie o'hanlonm lost her FDNY husband to 9/11 cancer in 2018 and pay tribute to the life he led.
- 9/11 illnesses; 1st responders: 2 years ago, vanesa rooney lost her 38 year old fdny husband, kevin, to 9/11 cancer- just 8 months after he was first diagnosed. she paid tribute to her late husband.
- 9/11 illnesses; community: nat spencer is a q104.3 listener suffering stage 4 breast cancer as a result of 9/11 toxins he was exposed to as an office worker who went back to work in the area a week after because the EPA declared the air was safe, which it wasn't. michael barasch is the head of the law firm which reps the most 9/11 victims.
- addiction; culture: leonard buschel is the founder of the reel recovery film festival, which is now in its 6th year- highlighting films about addiction .

- child labor; child trafficking: shraysi tandon directed "Invisble hands", focusing on child labor. shockingly, it is legal in the u.s. on farms, which has resulted in medical issues, especially on tobacco farms. the director also called out major companies who have ignored the issue and companies which did something about the problem.
- civil rights; music history; addictiON: "Horn From The Heart: the Paul Butterfield Story" is directed by John Anderson. Butterfield was more than a musician. he lioved civil rights with his bandmates and tragically died of drug abuse. the mpovie also entails his son's trauma after being separated from hsi dad because of his father's work absences.
- economy; poverty; incarceration; at risk youth: Antonio Mendes wrote and directed "life and nothign more" starring non actors in a movie about a black mom in florida trying to survive while trying to prevent her oldest son from following his convict dad's footsteps. regina williams stars. she is a waitress at waffle house.
- freedom of speech; drugs; censorhip; law: ronnie marmo stars in off boradway's "im not a cpmedian- i'm lenny bruce"- a one man show focusing on the ahead-of-his-time comedian's fight against censorship, which resonated today.
- government secrey; censorship; extra terrestrials: for the first time in 30 years, bob lazar has granted an interview after he came forward 3 decades earlier to say he worked on flying saucers in area 51. i spoke with the director who interviewed him for the doc "bob lazar: area 51 & ufo's"
