Grundy Habitat Building in Braceville – Grundy Three Rivers Habitat Board President Julie Wilkinson said they will be constructing their 14th house in Braceville sometime in 2019. WJDK interviewed Wilkinson regarding the announcement and the timeline. **Air dates:** 10/12

Major Crash Reported Near Saratoga School – Several local authorities responded to a DUI related crash that occurred near Saratoga School on October 13th. Four people were injured and Tasha Norris of Morris was arrested for DUI. Nearly a month later, Saratoga School officials were informed by State Representative David Welter that safety changes were coming to Route 47. **Air dates:** 10/13, 11/1

Morris Hospital Announces Huge Investment – Morris Hospital announced a \$60 million master facility plan. The facility plan includes modernization of the main hospital campus and the addition of two new medical facilities over the next three years. **Air dates:** 10/26

New Sheriff Elected in Grundy County – On November 7th, Grundy County residents elected Ken Briley as their newest Sheriff. Briley defeated Kevin Callahan who spent six years in the position. WJDK interviewed Briley after the election and in December about what he wants to accomplish. **Air dates: 11/08, 12/07**

Major Drug Dealer Arrested in Mazon – A major drug dealer was arrested by the Grundy County Sheriff's Department, Mazon Police Department, Will County Cooperative Police Assistance Team and Metropolitan Area Narcotics Unit at an apartment complex on December 19th. Sheriff Ken Briley said Ryan Linn, 39, of Morris had more than 300 grams of heroin and several other drugs in the complex. **Air Dates:** 12/20

Christmas Eve Fatal Crash – C.J. Loveland, 32, of Essex was killed in a DUI related crash that occurred on December 24th. Jonathon Loveland, 36, of Braidwood was arrested for his role in the crash. The Grundy County Emergency Management Agency, Braceville, Gardner, South Wilmington, Coal City and Wilmington Fire Departments assisted the scene. Air dates: 12/26, 12/27, 12/28
