**Mazon Teenager Arrested For Aggravated Domestic Battery** – Grundy County Sheriff Kevin Callahan said Riley Yard, 18, of Mazon was arrested for allegedly beating a female family member. The female family member was transported to an area hospital. **Air date:** 4/17

**Marseilles Baby Killer Sentenced** – A LaSalle County Judge handed down a 35-year-old prison sentence to Jeffrey Price, 31, of Marseilles who pled guilty to the murder of 9-day-old Ean Mariotto. Prosecutors say Price struck the head of Mariotto several times at a home on Clark Street in Marseilles on June 19<sup>th</sup>. **Air date:** 4/20

**Grundy Sheriff Deputy Indicted** – Zachary Entwistle, 25, of Morris and four other men were indicted for violating federal waterfowl hunting laws while leading a guided waterfowl hunt southwest of Havana, Illinois during the regular waterfowl season in December 2015. Grundy County Sheriff Kevin Callahan said Entwistle was placed on paid leave. **Air date:** 4/24

**Morris Gun Store Burglary Sentenced** – Alexis Pena, 18, of Morris pleaded guilty to unlawful possession of a defaced firearm and received four years in prison. Pena pointed a defaced firearm at a man in a truck near the Soap's Laundromat last December, just a few months after burglarizing a gun store in Morris. **Air date:** 5/10

**One Person Killed in Four Vehicle Crash** – The Illinois State Police, Gardner Fire Department, Grundy County Coroner's Office and several other agencies responded to a four vehicle crash that occurred on Interstate 55 near Braceville on May 14<sup>th</sup>. Coroner John Callahan said one person died from accident and 11 other people were injured. **Air Date:** 5/15

**42-year-old Homicide Cold Case Reopened** – The Grundy County Coroner's Office and Sheriff's Department reopened a case from 1976 involving a black female who was shot and killed as she was never identified. Coroner John Callahan believes a portion of DNA taken from evidence at the scene as well as a newly created sketch of the victim could help identify the woman. **Air dates:** 6/15, 6/16
