A) In the News: ongoing state pension reform saga, the closure of state facilities, how proposed state budget cuts threatened local social services and jobs, proposed weapons ban in Illinois, proposed same-sex marriage legislation in Illinois. Impact of federal sequester on area resources. New laws in effect as of 1/1.

B) Winter Weather: Stations provided broadcast any severe weather bulletins and advisories, and ongoing coverage where necessary, including any travel restrictions, road conditions, or event cancellations due to severe weather.

C) Health: We ran promos and made announcements regarding the American Heart Association's Go Red For Women heart health campaign...helped Heartland Regional Medical Center promote their Wine and Roses event for heart-healthy women....partnership with Hospice of Southern Illinois in support of their Red Carpet Gala, HSI's major fundraiser
