1. **On-Going Internship Program for Area College Students.** This on-going semester internship program has been in place at the station for at least six years. The station welcomes students from area universities and colleges who are motivated and excited about expanding their knowledge and hands-on experience in a vibrant broadcasting environment. Students must be enrolled in a program related to the broadcasting industry, and their internship must be endorsed, supported, and constantly monitored by the sponsoring university. Students are rewarded with course credit hours upon completion of the semester-long program. Internship periods include fall, spring and summer of each year. During the period covered by this report, KNSO has had 5 students from FSU, 1 student from Reedley College, and 1 student from Fresno City College.
2. **United Education Institute.** KNSO participated in the UEI 4th year anniversary open house event in July. For over 25 years, EUI College has served as a great choice for career preparation and training, and our tradition for excellence in education continues to grow. Station representatives were available to speak to participants about the station, community events and internship opportunities.
