Crime	Channel 11 News on FOX53	7/1	12AM	2:38	Police to crackdown on crime in South Side as shootings, fights and swaths of people spill into the narrow streets. Pittsburgh police say some nights the sidewalks are impassable with some people getting hit by cars. Police say motorcycle and bicycle patrol will be ticketing or towing cars. Police state that after initial warnings, \$300 citations will be handed out to those who block public passageways and those who don't comply could be arrested.
Crime	Channel 11 News on FOX53	7/4	12AM	:30	The 4th of July holiday weekend has brought an increase in officers patrolling the rivers and lakes locally as part of the national "Operation Dry Water" Campaign. Officers are enforcing boating under the influence laws as well as doing boat safety checks. Police warn that there are serious penalties for DUI so to avoid that designate a sober driver.
Crime	Channel 11 News on FOX53	7/4	12AM	:41	Due to the rise in violence, which includes multiple shootings, the Giant Eagle in South Side has changed its Wharton Street location hours to close at 9pm instead of 10pm. Safety is the top priority and a violent fight in the store last week prompted the store closing time change.
Crime	Channel 11 News on FOX53	8/17	12AM	:27	Officials in Oakmont want the false alarms to stop. Council members want to begin fining people for repeated false alarms citing that police and fire department resources are drained by having to respond to them. Under a proposed ordinance, fines would start at \$50-\$75 and increase each time police or fire are called to the same property. Officials say the fine proposals are not designed to be money makers but a deterrent. Council plans to adopt the ordinance next month.

Dozens of doctors, nurses and other licensed medical professionals were among the people charged in the investigation. Executives apparently paid doctors and nurses to order unnecessary equipment, testing and pain medicine and the money was used on cars, yachts and real estate.
Crime	Channel 11 News on FOX53	19	12AM	:21	United States customs stopped a shipment of fake sport memorabilia. The haul included championship rings from the NY Yankees, Chicago Bulls and Philadelphia Eagles. If they were real, the 86 rings would be worth more than two million dollars. The shipment came from China and was bound for Missouri. Custom is reminding sports fans not to be scammed by paying huge prices for counterfeit items.
Economy	Channel 11 News on FOX53	7/1	12AM	:34	The City of Pittsburgh's finances took a hit in 2020 and the city controller hopes it was due to the pandemic and not because of people leaving town. The city ended the year with a \$50,000,000 deficit and reserves dropped from \$133,000,000 to \$85,000,000. The main driver of the city's finances is tax revenue funded by people who live and work in Pittsburgh. The 7 county region saw the loss of almost 11,000 workers in May alone. There is a silver lining, though. The city received \$335,000,000 in covid relief from the American Rescue Plan.

According to the Pittsburgh Business Times, the company wants to bring in nearly 100 new employees leading up to the store's opening in September. Public Lands is a specialty store for all kinds of outdoor activities, such as biking, camping, fishing and skiing. It will be across from the Walmart Supercenter in Cranberry off of Route 19.

The 550 billion dollar legislation is over 2,000 pages and would increase the nation's spending on roads, bridges, public transit and much more. The bill would be financed from a number of federal sources, including repurposing untapped covid relief and relying on projected future economic growth.

Once refineries return, prices are expected to come down as demand drops after Labor Day. More than 95% of oil production at offshore platforms and rigs in the gulf were shut down ahead of Ida.
