



## **Free Time/Use Documentation Form**

This form is used to document free time provided to political candidates that constitutes a “use” that is not exempt from “equal opportunities.” Examples of a qualifying use include on-air talent that is also a candidate for political office, or a political candidate that appears on a PSA broadcast. This form must be uploaded to the relevant station’s online public file on the FCC’s website **as soon as possible after the use occurs, i.e., within one business day of the use.** Consult the Zimmer Compliance Manual for further information and definitions of relevant terms.

Some uses by a political candidate are considered exempt from triggering this requirement. The following items are considered exempt programming:

- Bona fide newscasts
- Bona fide news interviews
- Bona fide news documentaries
- On-the-spot-coverage of bona fide news events
