

WAKR, WONE-FM, WQMX, WNWV 2022 3rd Quarter Community Issues/Programs

Earlier this year, a survey was conducted by the Center for Marketing and Opinion Research to assess the community needs facing Northeast Ohio and Summit County. According to the most recent information we have, the problems noted during the period fell into the following categories (presented in order of importance):

- 5. Substance Abuse/Heroin
- 6. Housing
- a. Homelessness
- b. Lack of Affordable Housing
- c. Vacant or Neglected Properties
- 7. Healthcare
 - a. COVID 19
 - b. Access to Care
 - c. Cost of care
 - d. Mental Health Issues

- 8. Social & Ethical Issues
 - a. Climate Change
 - b. Racial Divisions
 - c. Education Inequality

NOTE: Previously, COVID has been reported as the primary concern facing our region. While we continue to discuss Covid care and health issues surround that, this year, economic issues were mentioned by over 20% of the sample and has emerged as the #1 concern across NE Ohio.

INFLATION/FUEL PRICES: During the first 6-months of 2022, Inflation and Fuel Costs have emerged as an important issue. Groceries and commuting costs are rising and creating hardships for many. Also, housing costs are a major concern. While Northeast Ohio enjoys a comparatively low cost of living, recent increases are just a painful here as they are in traditionally more expensive regions.

Regularly Scheduled Programs

In addition to the programs listed, stations also provided the following regularly scheduled news and community service programming:

WAKR News – 3:00 length local newscasts 5am-9am M-F at the top and bottom of each of each hour 5:30a-8:30a, and top of the hour following CBS News 9a-1p.

CBS News – airs on 1590 WAKR Newscasts are 6:00 in length until 9am M-F, with the exception of the World News Roundup at 8:00 a.m. M-F (10 minutes) and 1-min hourly updates throughout the day.

WAKR Ray Horner Show – 6:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday. News, sports, weather, traffic, business and topical interviews of local, national and community interest.

America in the Morning - airs on 1590 WAKR 5a-6a M-F with topical news, sports, business and information. 54:00 length. Network program.

WONE News – 1:30 length hourly local newscasts 6a-8a weekdays. These newscasts are conversational in nature and air at 6:40am, 7:40am and 8:40am.

WQMX News – 2:30 length local newscasts 5:30a-8:30a at the top and bottom of each hour weekdays.

Weather Updates - all stations present weather updates at least every hour during live programming and break in to programming when severe weather events warrant.

Traffic Updates - All stations: regular traffic and highway construction updates at least four times each hour on WAKR, WONE & WQMX during weekday mornings. Updates are provided weekday afternoons as needed.

Spectrum – produced by the RCRG Newsroom presenting in-depth treatment of local, regional and national issues. Some programs also include presentations of the City Club of Cleveland highlighting a wide range of programming. Airs on WAKR, WONE-FM & WNWV. More detail on this program is provided elsewhere in this report.

Forum 360 – produced by the Jewish Community Center of Akron in association with the Rubber City Radio Group, a 30-minute program airs each Monday morning at 12:30 a.m. on WAKR and Sunday at 6:30 a.m. on WONE at 5:30 p.m. on WAKR depending on sports schedules.

Center Talks – produced by the Akron Urban League and 1590 WAKR with information on agencies and programs of benefit to the Akron urban community. This program runs 30:00.

My Beautiful Home - on 1590 WAKR with hosts Katherine DeLong and Andy January with information on home décor and preserving value for homeowners. Saturday 11:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. This program also airs Sunday evenings on replay.

CBS Weekend Roundup - a 48:00 minute review of the week's biggest news stories. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

CBS Face the Nation - a 58:00 program with news and debate originating in Washington, D.C. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

107.3 Cares: During the period, WNWV produced a series of public service announcements in support of community agencies of interest to the 107.3 audience. Target agencies include the Cleveland Adoption Network, Greater Cleveland Animal Protective League and "because I said I would" (A Character Education organization.)

RCRG Community Outreach

As part of our continued community outreach, RCRG works in partnership with various community groups to both raise funds and help operations of non-profit charitable groups and profile worthwhile community events. Among the initiatives for this quarter:

All Stations Participated in these Community Events

- May 21st. All four stations sponsored a "Vehicle Safety Check and Document Shredding" event. On Saturday, from 10-4, in the radio station's parking lot, in West Akron. Free automobile safety checks were performed by the Ohio Highway Patrol and we had a document shredding company on hand to take peoples documents. The City of Akron's Police Force was on hand to handle the inspections. Over a hundred cars were checked and a truckload of shredded materials were collected.
- June 4th. All four stations participated in our Annual Pet Expo an West Akron's Hardesty Park.

 Rescue organizations from around Northeast Ohio brought rescue animals for adoption.

 This was our 21st year, doing this event. Over 20 shelters participated. More information is available at https://petexpo.rcrg.net/.

WAKR Hosted or Participated in the following Comminuty Events:

• WAKR Law Day: On May 9th, WAKR and The Akron Bar Association teamed up for a free day of legal advice. Attorneys fielded over 50 calls and over 20 text messages from listeners. Most topics were centered around family, domestic and labor law. This was hosted by WAKR's Ray Horner. The Akron Bar was represented by attorneys Dean Carro, Gary Rosen and Linda Ulinski.

WQMX Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **WQMX Charity Concert** with Priscilla Block: This was a special concert featuring Rising Country Start, Priscilla Block, on July 8th, at The Dusty Armadillo. This was a fundraiser for WQMX's Bosom Buddies Charitable project, which provides mammograms to those who cannot afford them. \$7,175 was raised at this event.
- **WQMX Annual Golf Outing:** Fundraiser for NEOPAT held on August 1st. The Northeast Ohio Foundation for Patriotism which provides assistance to families of current US Servicemen, and Veterans. The event was held at the Raintree Golf and Event Center, and raised \$5,620.
- **Akron Heart Walk:** This event is produced by the Heart Association and hosted by WQMX's Scott Wynn. It was held on September 10th. WQMX also provided on air support to the Heart Association in order to make the event successful.
- **WQMX Clambake**: Charitable event was held on Sept. 11th and raised donations for NEOPAT. A total of \$3,995 was raised.

- Taste of the Pro Football Hall of Fame Sept. 13th. This event generates good will and donations for the Akron-Canton Food Bank. The Food Bank's CEO, Dan Flowers, was a guest on the WQMX morning show, on Sept. 8th in support of the event.
- **WQMX Charity Concert** with Jon Langston: This was a special concert featuring Rising Country Start, Priscilla Block, on Sept 22nd, at The Dusty Armadillo. This was a fundraiser for NEOPAT. \$8,240 was raised at this event.
- **WQMX Pet Rescue**: A continuing on air feature which presents adoptable pets every Thursday morning at 8:40.

WONE Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **Pet of The Week:** The WONE Morning team interviews representative's from the Summit County Humane Society every Wednesday. Homeless pets are featured, usually one cat and one dog, as a way to get these animals adopted.
- WONE Operation Heroes Dine & Donate WONE partners with local restaurants to host Dine & Donate days to benefit the Valor Home of Summit County. Each restaurant designates a day that they will set aside 25% of each check to the Valor Home. The radio station promotes the event and encourages listeners to participate by stopping in for lunch. Local restaurants that participated include:
 - o July 20th. Crazy Chicken in Green Twp. (\$457.25 was raised.)
 - o Sept. 21st. Steak 'n Shake at Chapel Hill. (\$745 was raised.)
- Taste of the Pro Football Hall of Fame Sept. 13th. This event generates good will and donations for the Akron-Canton Food Bank. The Food Bank's CEO, Dan Flowers, was a guest on the WONE morning show, on Sept. 8th in support of the event.
- **WONE Split The Pot.** Each Friday during June, WONE hosts "Rock The Lock" in Downtown Akron's Lock 3 Park. The event features music by tribute bands and various food vendors. Part of WONE's involvement includes a fundraiser for the Valor Home of Summit County which supports homeless war veterans. Over \$1,500 was raised during 3rd quarter.
- American Heart Association. On Sept. 7th, representative's of the Heart Assn. joined the WONE Morning Show to discuss what they do and to generate interest in the Fundraoser which was held on Sept. 10th.

WAKR Community Programming:

<u>Ray Horner Morning Show:</u> This program airs 5:30a – 9:00a, Monday-Friday with the exception of major holidays. It provides regular newscasts, sports, traffic and weather in addition to a regular listing of community, news and topical interviews.
