COVID-19 COVERAGE ON WEB AND SOCIAL MEDIA

Since April 1, WAOW has produced approximately 600 stories related to COVID-19 locally. Content related to this topic is the most viewed content on our website, and most engaged with on our social media pages. It includes updates on cases / deaths / specific outbreaks in the state, information on closures / cancellations / reopening's, information on testing, medical information, and highlights community effort.

WAOW also live streamed 20 events on our website and Facebook page related to COVID-19. They include the Wisconsin DHS coronavirus pressers, White House pressers, and call outs to local content related to COVID-19. The pressers from Wisconsin DHS gave information on the latest figures on the spread of the virus, ways people can stay safe, and announced programs to the public on safety measures to prevent spread. These pressers are usually at least an hour in length.

WAOW broadcast approximately 10 hours of live press conferences from Governor Tony Evers related to COVID-19. Those press conferences were also broadcast on our digital platforms. The station also live streamed on May 5 the Wisconsin Supreme Court hearing arguments for the state's Safer-At-Home order. The hearing was 1:45 long and showed from a virtual setting how the process worked at the state's highest court. The Safer-at-Home order was struck down.

WAOW created a carry out and delivery guide on our website. It compiled lists from three area Chamber of Commerce and listed individual businesses offerings. WAOW had a guide for Safer-at-Home that detailed what residents and businesses were able to do under the order, gave resources and listed the expected length of the order. WAOW also made ABC daily special reports accessible from our website.
