

Political File Consent Decree Compliance Report

I, Mark McVey, the designated Compliance Officer in the above-referenced matter, state as follows with regard to the above-captioned Political File Consent Decree:

Attached hereto is a spreadsheet prepared by me documenting requests received by Tri-Rivers Broadcasting Company ("Company") for the purchase of broadcast time by, or on behalf of, legally qualified candidates for public office or which communicate a message relating to any political matter of national importance during the three month reporting period preceding the November 2, 2021, general election. As shown by the report, the Company had no requests for such broadcast time.

The Company has established a Political File Compliance Plan and continues to implement and utilize its Political File Compliance Plan and its procedures. The Compliance Plan explains the requirements set forth in the Political Record-keeping Statutes and Rules and includes Operating Procedures that Covered Employees must follow to ensure compliance with the relevant statutes and rules. The Operating Procedures include internal procedures and policies specifically designed to ensure that the station uploads all required information to the online political files in a timely manner so as to maintain full, complete, and up-to-date information. The Operating Procedures also include a checklist detailing the steps that a Covered Employee must follow to ensure compliance with the relevant statutes and rules.

The company is not aware of any instance of noncompliance with the terms and conditions of the Consent Decree during the reporting period.

I make this statement from personal knowledge because I developed the Company's Compliance Manual, Operating Procedures, compliance checklist, Compliance Training Program, distributed and reviewed the Manual with relevant personnel and trained Covered Employees as to its components and requirements. I am in regular communication with station personnel concerning relevant matters and am also personally involved in the ongoing review of the Compliance Plan, including revisions as needed, to ensure that the information remains current, complete, accurate and effective.

Capitalized terms not defined in this statement have the same definition as stated in the above-captioned Consent Decree.


