- Bank employee Aurora Barerra walks into her East L.A. bank telling her co-worker that she has been kidnapped, has a bomb strapped to her torso, and is instructed to rob the bank or else she would be blown up. Only after she is rescued do cops slowly unravel the stunning real story. Jay Schadler reports.
- Why would a young English teacher risk her career and her marriage to have sexual contact with students at her Plymouth, PA high school? Lauren Harrington Cooper pled guilty to sexual contact with students and corrupting minors. Deborah Roberts reports.

Who killed Greg Williams, a prosperous Keller, TX entrepreneur? His wife, Michelle Williams, tells police an intruder entered the house, hit her with a wrench, and shot Greg with his own gun. As police start to peel back the façade of the Williams' happy life, they uncover their secret world of shady business, duplicity, and kinky sex. Could Michelle be covering or perhaps it was her hand on the trigger. Matt Gutman reports.

THE MOOCHERS

- **Workers Comp:** "20/20" uncovers scores of people accused of faking injuries to claim disability and workers compensation benefits – costing taxpayers hundreds of millions of dollars. Cecilia Vega rides shotgun with two private eyes hired to crack down on suspects.
- **Bogus Broker:** Shannon Lee is accused of illegally claiming ownership of vacant homes -- selling some, renting others, and letting her alleged partner in crime live in another (Shannon was also living in one). But police say it all came crashing down when she snatched the home of a police department employee. Gio Benitez is there as the law came knocking.
- **Defaulting Doctors:** So many of us have student loan burdens, but doctors, who make an average of \$187k a year? DO YOUR “&@#%*” JOB

- There may be no boss who commands more power than a movie director. But what happens when the safety of the crew is allegedly ignored all for the sake of getting “the perfect shot?” A dream sequence scene on active train tracks turns into a nightmare and tragically, camera assistant Sarah Jones, is killed and three others are critically wounded. Sarah’s death shocks the film community. Director, Randall Miller and others are now facing criminal charges for involuntary manslaughter and have pleaded not guilty, but has Miller previously been cavalier about safety during filming. Chris Connelly reports.
- Our lives are literally in their hands. But when a first responder makes a mistake, you could be on your own. Medic Mills, a 77-year-old man in Washington DC, had a heart attack right near a firehouse, but the firefighters refused to help him, and when his daughter called 911, the dispatcher sent the ambulance to a wrong address miles away. Are the stresses of their jobs hurting us? Jim Avila reports.
- So many of us have done it -- caught a few ‘zzzs’ on the job. Some 21st century companies even offer nap rooms. But make no mistake, falling asleep on the job can still be a career killer -- especially if your catnap is caught on camera. “Shark Tank’s” Robert Herjavec, Lori Greiner, and Mark Cuban sound off. Chris Connelly reports.
- There is no greater temptation to misbehave at work than when you have decided to quit. Just ask former Alaska TV reporter Charlo Greene, whose “Good Night and Good Riddance” sayonara rocketed to instant infamy. Greene proudly and unapologetically defends her actions to 20/20.

- “Shark Tank’s” Robert Herjavec reveals some classic techniques and mind games the best salesmen deploy to seal the deal, from the “Standing Room Only” to the “Artisan.” Hannah Storm reports.
- There’s a knock at the door – it’s a salesman trying to sell you a home security system to protect you from thieves. But is he the bigger threat to your wallet? Brian Ross reports.
- As the nation’s largest retailer of used vehicles, CarMax advertises that each of the used vehicles it offers for sale is “CarMax Quality Certified” and has undergone a rigorous “125+ point inspection.” But a former CarMax manager alleges that vehicles with major problems made it through the inspection process and were sold to customers. Gio Benitez reports.
- Asia Newson is known as Detroit’s Youngest Entrepreneur. At just 11 years old, she makes and sells her own candles under her business “Super Business Girl.” Her real talent comes with the selling. Jay Schadler reports.

SWAT TEAM RAID

A night-time raid by a SWAT team in rural Georgia resulted in the maiming of an 18-month-old boy when a “flash-bang” grenade landed in his crib. Police broke down the door expecting to find a drug dealer and instead found a family of four small children visiting relatives. After more than a month in a medically-induced coma and numerous surgeries, “Bou Bou” Phonesavanh left the hospital with more than \$1,000,000 in medical bills. But when the hospital asked county officials to pay for their SWAT team’s mistake, they refused. And a controversial grand jury decision left a family and a community calling for justice. Matt Gutman reports.

PACKAGE THEFTS

This season over one billion packages will be delivered, and with so many of those dropped on doorsteps, thieves see an opportunity to swipe some pricey loot. But homeowners around the country are getting more creative in their attempts to combat package pilferers. One family in West Virginia rigged their house up with cameras and when presents they’d ordered disappeared they went straight to the videotape. Plus, a Portland, Oregon police department has taken it upon themselves to become Santa’s newest helpers -- returning the stolen items to families all over and ensuring this Grinch won’t steal Christmas. Matt Gutman reports.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Hannah Overton spent the past seven holiday seasons in jail, serving time for the 2006 death of her son Andrew. She was convicted of neglecting to get Andrew medical care when he grew ill. He died of hypernatremia (salt poisoning). Her defenders say Andrew had behavioral and eating problems that caused his acute and rare illness. Just last week, an appeals court in Texas overturned the conviction, and Overton was released from jail. “20/20” reports.
