LOCAL ISSUES ADDRESSED DURING THE QUARTER

The following are local issues of concern to the community. Programs that addressed these issues during this reporting period are listed as follows.

Local Issue/Concern	Brief description of local issue or concern
Education Issues	It's important for students to have access to a quality education as we prepare them for college and the workforce. It's also important for cities and counties to have excellent school districts because we know outstanding education systems attract new industry, businesses and jobs. The quality of the education system is the first thing employers and families look for when relocating. WTOK continues to focus on education.
Economic Development	We've shown viewers how important economic development is for communities to thrive. There's a local push to strengthen economic development partnerships, including creating a regional, economic development authority.
Crime	Crime continues to be a problem in Meridian. The city and police department are addressing the issue, but is it enough? What's being done to lower the crime rate and to stop violent crimes? WTOK is holding local officials accountable. WTOK is also focusing on domestic violence/abuse awareness and prevention.
Downtown Meridian Development	Development in downtown Meridian and revitalizing the downtown area have been important goals for the city. We reported on new businesses opening in downtown, including new entertainment destinations and museums and talked to city leaders about what this means for Meridian and how they're managing the growth.
Drug Epidemic	Drug crimes and drug addiction are serious problems in Mississippi and Alabama. Prescription drug abuse (opioids) continues to reach crisis levels and some communities are now dealing with cocaine and heroin problems. We're tackling the problem by talking to drug and mental health experts and to law enforcement.
Tourism/Travel/Area Attractions/Recreation	Recreation is an important part of leading a balanced life and WTOK is committed to showcasing local tourist attractions, historic sites, and entertainment destinations available for both locals and visitors.

- At a toy store, a young boy loves the dolls and selects one for his mother to buy him. But she is determined to have him pick out what she considers a boy's toy. A young girl wants to play with a truck, but her mother does not agree with her choice. What will other shoppers think when they see the mother's disapproval? (OAD: 7/28/17)
- A mom coaches her clearly musically gifted son as he plays the guitar, but nothing the child does is good enough. Will others step in? (OAD: 6/26/15)

- A woman asks a bartender to charge her cell phone behind the bar. When she walks away, the bartender starts reading her texts and emails. He even tries to share her personal photos with others at the bar. Will anyone at the bar speak up? (OAD: 5/29/15)
- A man asks a shopper standing in line at the supermarket if he can cut in front of him since he is in a rush. The shopper agrees and when the man who cut the line begins to check out, sounds ring out and he is informed that he is the store's 500 millionth customer and just won a two-week trip to Hawaii. How will the shoppers who let the man cut in line react when they realize they were so close to winning the prize? (OAD: 6/6/14)
