BOSTON COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL DISCIPLINING A STUDENT AFTER AN INCIDENT INVOLVING AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE. THERE ARE REPORTS AN UPSKIRTING SCANDAL FORCED THE ALL-BOYS SCHOOL IN DORCHESTER TO EXPELL A STUDENT THIS SEMESTER. BUT A B-C HIGH SPOKESPERSON REFUSED TO GIVE US ANY *SPECIFICS ABOUT WHAT HAPPENED. INSTEAD, RELEASING A STATEMENT THAT SAYS, QUOTE: "BC HIGH IS VIGILANT ABOUT OUR STUDENTS' ACCESS TO THE INTERNET, AND THE POTENTIAL DAMAGE TO ANYONE'S PRIVACY IN THE USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES. WITHOUT COMMENTING ON SPECIFIC EVENTS IN ORDER TO INSURE THE PRIVACY OF OUR FAMILIES, PERIODICALLY BC HIGH, LIKE ALL SCHOOLS, HAS TO TAKE DISCIPLINARY MEASURES AND ADJUST OUR PROCEDURES TO PROTECT OUR COMMUNITY MEMBERS."

Slug=TEEN SLEEP STUDY

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS NOT GETTING ENOUGH SLEEP. THAT'S ACCORDING TO A NEW STUDY. RESEARCHERS AT COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY FOUND THAT ONLY A SMALL PERCENTAGE OF TEENS GET THE RECOMMENDED AMOUNT OF SLEEP. THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION RECOMMENDS A SOLID 9 OR 10 HOURS OF SLEEP FOR TEENS. THE STUDY FOUND THAT 95 PERCENT OF 12TH GRADERS DID NOT MEET THIS AND THAT AS THE GRADE LEVEL INCREASED THE AMOUNT OF SLEEP *DECREASED.

NEW RESEARCH ON FAST FOOD SUGGESTS IT'S BAD FOR THE BRAIN. THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY STUDY FOUND CHILDREN WHO EAT THE MOST FAST FOOD PERFORMED THE WORST ON MATH, SCIENCE, AND READING TESTS. EXPERTS BELIEVE THE LACK OF IRON IN FAST FOOD COULD SLOW DOWN BRAIN PROCESSES. AND THAT DIETS HIGH IN FAT AND SUGAR HAVE A NEGATIVE IMPACT ON LEARNING. 52-PERCENT OF CHILDREN SURVEYED HAD EATEN FAST FOOD UP TO THREE TIMES A WEEK.
