Issue: Sheriff's Office Produces Bountiful Garden

The garden at the CC Sheriff's Office has yielded a huge bounty and as a result many types of vegetables will be donated to the Loaves and Fishes Food Bank as well as reduce the cost for feeding inmates.

The program aired on July 6th, 2015 and was 1.5 minutes in length on KTHS Local News.

Issue: Funds Available for Charitable Programs in Carroll County

Nonprofits in Carroll County can begin applying for Giving Tree Grants through the CC Community Foundation, an affiliate of the Arkansas Community Foundation. Grants range from \$300-\$3,000.

Issue: Berryville Commercial Historic District Meeting

AHPP is having a public meeting for Berryville residents about putting the Berryville Commercial Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places. Building owners would be eligible for a 20% tax credit.


Program was 1 minute in length and aired September 25, 2015 on the 7am, noon and 5pm KTHS NEWS.
